As a result of the above information Roman DOBRIANSKI, was interviewed and advised the following:

> Early in 1966 Roman DOBRIANSKI wrote to subject inviting him to visit his relatives in Canada. Although subject was granted a Canadian non immigrant visa considerable difficulty was encountered in obtaining permission from the Soviet authorities to leave the U.S.S.R. In an effort to overcome these difficulties subject sought and obtained the assistance of a neighbour and former school mate, a Mr. SHEWCHUK. Subject referred to SHEWCHUK as a influential member of the Soviet Government. With the assistance of SHEWCHUK, subject was able to obtain permission to leave the U.S.S.R. for a period of two months on the condition that his wife and children would remain behind.

On November 4, 1966 subject arrived at Winnipeg, Manitoba and with the exception of a short trip to Saskatoon, Saskatchewan in December, 1966, remained at Roman DOBRIANSKI's residence. He returned to the U.S.S.R. on January 11, 1967. To the best of Roman DOBRIANSKI's knowledge, subject was not in contact with anyone other than relatives during his visit to Canada".

Our records contain no adverse references to Roman DOBRIANSKI who was born April 1, 1908 at Czernelica, Horodenka, Stanislawow, Poland and is presently a priest at the Blessed Virgin Mary (Ukrainian Catholic) Church, Winnipeg, Manitoba.
