15. SKULENKO (continued). He is quite often seen in company of VESOLOVSKY Bohdan and BACHYNSKY Omelan, both of Ukrainian Desk, CBC Montreal. He also accompanied ROMANOV Cleksnadr on his visits to the CBC and at private parties arranged by Vesolovsky and Bachynsky. Incidentally, VESOLOVSKY plans eventually to visit Kiev , preferably on official business of the CBC.

16. \*PLOTNIKOV V.K. of Kharkov, Ukrainian, aged 40, 5'5, slim, bald, brown eyes, speaks fair English. Engineer by profession. Knows personally I. MURATOV and claimed to be very fond of Ukrainian poetry. In his opinion, KORNIYCHUK has done very much for Ukrainian culture and is a great man. PLOTNIKOV showed a great interest in the activities of Ukrainian emigration, wanted to know what organizations there were abroad, what schools, etc. He suggested to # 7 to talk with Ihor VASKEVYCH (?), an engineer of Lvov, at the Expo with Electronic machines. PLOTNIKOV was given Yuri Klen, volume III, on 8 June 1967 by # 7.

SN \*VASKEVYCH, Igor, aged 35, claimed to be Russian living in Lvov since 1944, therefore speaking perfect Ukrainian. 5'7, slim, blond hairs, electronics engineer, married. He often watched Polish television and likes Polish programs very much. He also watches other than <sup>Polish &</sup> Soviet TV. As an electronics engineer he happened to make "all the necessary adjustments" in his own TV for that purpose. VASKEVYCH listens also to foreign radio broadcasts and in particular to Ukrainian broadcasts in Poland. He recommended to # 7 to talk with LAVRYK, Mykola Petrovych ( para 1).

18. \* BLIZNYCHENKO, Koryna Leonidovna (?) female, Ukrainian, daughter of a scholar, at the Expo with the Department "of study of oceans and seas" (oceanography?). This is her maiden name, so far she did not tell her husband's name. Nothing interesting. Speak poor Ukrainian.

19. \* ZGERSKY (ZGERSKY), Anatoli Volodymyrovych, an employee of the Ottava Soviet Embassy assigned for the time being to the Expo. Speaks fine Ukrainian and English. Sticks to official line.

19. \* LOMKO, Yakiv Oleksiyovych, Ukrainian, speaks poor Ukrainian, Upolnomochenny for the Expo, nothing interesting so far.

20. \* KYRYK, Mykola Mykolayevych, Ukrainian, of Kiev, guide at the exemplary kolhosp of Shlakhova. Nothing of particular interest.

21. Dr F.P. TRINUS, Ukrainian, interested in Ukrainian emigre affairs, was asking for postcards with Shevchenko Monument in Washington, D.C.

22. LUBIMSKYY (LUBIMSKY) Arkadiy Abramovich, probably Jewish, speaks fine Ukrainian, upolnomochenny for Expo affairs.
