1. Subject is daughter of Nikolas Holub of San Francisco, Cal. (246-12Ave, San Francisco 94 118, tel. BA 1 - 9626), by his first wife. Subject is married now to George Tomashevsky of Kiev, who at one time was head of Komsomol of Kiev rayon.

Subject visited her father and New York City in Oct/Nov 1967 on affidavit of some friend of Nikolas Holub who is working in some aerodynamic project (space program?) She was in NYC during SKVE Convention.

In Aug 1969 Subject arrived again in the States for a 3 month visit.

Subject is employed by a draft-construction bureau in Kiev. She is an engineer by profession.

2. Subject's daughter fnu is married to YERSHOV, fnu of Kiev who visited France recently with a Ukrainian Ensemble from Kiev. She is also an engineer -constructor.
