1. PACKAGE PROGRAM

A. Description and Content

This project was set up to develop support for clandestine operations establishing and saintsining communication and supply channels using overt mails into the Ukrainian SSR. The parcels containing such items as woolen yard goods, head scarfs, clothing, soap, gloves, leather for footwear, powdered milk, scissors, razors, eye glasses, bed linens, blankets and drugs have been mailed to the Soviet Ukraine since December 1956.

During the period 1 December 1956 through May 1958, 18 percels were smiled. Receipt of the percels has been acknowledged by letter in all cases. In only one case was there something missing from a percel; i.e., 5½ yerds of woelen material missing from one of the percels. It is possible that missing articles may not have been reported by the recipient for fear that the sender would become discouraged from sending other packages in the future. Seven percels have been mailed since October 1958. The details regarding actual costs and receipt of these percels have not yet been obtained from the principal agent.

B. Addressess

Addressees are friends and acquaintences of the ANCASSOWARIES and their representatives in the west and families of former underground members.

C. Addressors

Addressors may be fictitious names with true addresses or individuals who are related to or are acquaintances of the addresses. The addressors, in the majority of cases, are located in Canada, although a few are located in the United States. The parcels usually are mailed through agencies established for the mailing of parcels to the USSK and which guarantee delivery of the parcels.

Agency traces have been performed on all names used as addressors.

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D. Cost to Agency

During the period 1 December 1956 through May 1958, 18 percels were mailed at an average cost of \$110. Receipt of the percels has been acknowledged by letter in every case. Seven percels have been mailed since October 1958. All the details regarding actual costs and receipt of these latter percels have not yet been obtained from the principal agent.

There are no salaries paid for the activities under this program.

E. Effectiveness

Correspondence received in connection with this mailing progress has produced information concerning former underground members and positive intelligence which has been disseminated in reports on at least 2 occassions. Although the project originally did not provide for the gathering of positive intelligence, an effort will be made in the future to gather such information from the correspondence received for dissemination to the intelligence community.

These parcels also serve as a PP medium. In a recent interview a Ukrainian emigre had with a representative of the American Committee, he reported that parcels from the U. S. A. make favorable propagands. When an individual receives a package, the whole region learns about it. The value of the parcels is so high that a worker in the USER could not afford to buy it.

2. INFORMATION BULLETIN

A. Content

The Bulletin reports those happenings in the USBR and the Soviet orbit countries which affect Ukrainian interests. It presents factual world news and news of Ukrainian emigre activities and achievements in the west; analyses the affects of Soviet policies on the economic, social, cultural, and political life of the Ukrainian people. It presents the program of the UKVR (Ukrainian Supreme Liberation Council) and attempts to foster and maintain a feeling of Ukrainian national consciousness.

B. Description

The Bulletin is 63" x 63" in size, and is 11 pages long (sample attached). It is mailed in business or personal size savelopes.

C. Addressess

The Bulletin is mailed to provincial, municipal and raion institutes; newspaper and publishing houses, scientific institutes, schools, associations, theater houses, city and village libraries and clubs.

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and members and officials of the Communist party in the Ukraine. The list of addressees has been selected from overt Soviet internal and external publications and from the publication of The Committee for Return to The Homeland. In some cases a letter of explanation accompanies the Bulletin giving the source from which the addressee's name and address was obtained. This is done in order to clear the individual in the event he because suspect because he received mail of a nationalist nature from the Vest.

D. Addressers

The Bulletin is mailed from approximately 10 countries in the free world, including west Germany. The addressors are fictitious and the addresses are those of large apartment buildings or business houses selected at random from western telephone directories.

8. Cost to Agency

A total of _______ mas allotted in the budget for this progrem during fiscal 1959. Between 4500 and 6,000 copies of the Bulletin have been mailed monthly, at an average cost of 1850 per copy. This cost includes not only the stamps and envelopes, but the time involved for article compositions, typing, and addressing of envelopes, research and the lag work involved in order to deliver the mail to the various post offices.

F. Addresses Response or Effectiveness

Through August 1957 there were 12 responses received to the Bulletin. Four responses were favorable, 4 were in disagreement and presented attacks on the UNVR and the individuals involved, 2 were non-committed in comment but merely acknowledged receipt of the Bulletin. Since August 1957 responses were received. Copies of the letters are on file in SR/3-FP and may be obtained on request.

An effort now is underway to determine new ways for mailing the Bulletin which might provide a better chance of its reaching the addressees.

How can the people believe your nationalist propagants when the Ukrainian nationalists diagraced themselves before the whole world with their activities. In word, they claim to be patriots but in deed they have proved themselves to be stranglers of the Ukrainian nation and have deceived the Ukraine by their very move.

When the German fascists escupied the Ukraine in 1941, the nationalists under the direction of their "leaders" Benders and Helnyk went into their service. This is not an invented fact it is the truth. With their most active help the fascist occupiers burned and ruined 714 cities and settlements in the Ukraine, burned 28 thousand villages, robbed and ruined huge examts of national wealth. General damages by fascists and nationalists in the Ukraine smount to 285 killion karbovantchi.

And how many people did the fascists together with the nationalists kill in the Ukrains? At their hands 250 people perished in only one Stanislavs'ka Oblasti

And what did the Ukrainian nationalists do in Bukovyna? On 25 Hovember 1946 in the village of Klynyvtchi in our raion, Handeriytchi killed 11 men. In one night alone in the village of Ispes, Vyzhnytsky raion, 41 men died at the hands of the nationalists. The nationalists took no pity on the elders or the children.

There was directated in the Ukraino recently the news that in the city of Cherromeanniyak in Rovensholyan there was an open trial of CDN bandits.

There were found in deep wells in the Malynchy raise hundreds of corps of the city occupants. Investigation revealed that the crualest acts were performed on the individuals before they were killed. The cutting and twisting off of limbs, dismemberment of vital organs, gradual extensions, twisting of makes, etc. Many of them were thrown into the wells alive. During the trial there were many vitnesses who found making the dead their family and relatives. The vitnesses, as one, said that these terrible acts were performed by bendits of the OLE during the fascist occupation of the Exemple.

In early August of this year the residents of the city of Dorobysych, (illegible) Raion in Volymia from the bottom of a deep well recovered the remains of many of their relatives and friends who were markered by bendits of the OUR. They will not escape the revenge of the people for these acts.

That is what the Ukrainian nationalists were like indeed - murderers, plumierers and traitors. Taxas SEEVCHENEO, ridiculing traitors of the Ukrainian people, wrote thus:

"For a piece of spoiled summage You will even sail your mother."

What do you expect, gentlemen nationalists, of the UNVR for the distribution of your Bullstine?

You will find no ayemathy here. The word "nationalist" to us carries the same meaning as the word "fascist".

Once again we advise you to discontinue sending your foul writing and contemplate a bit about what awaits you in the future.
