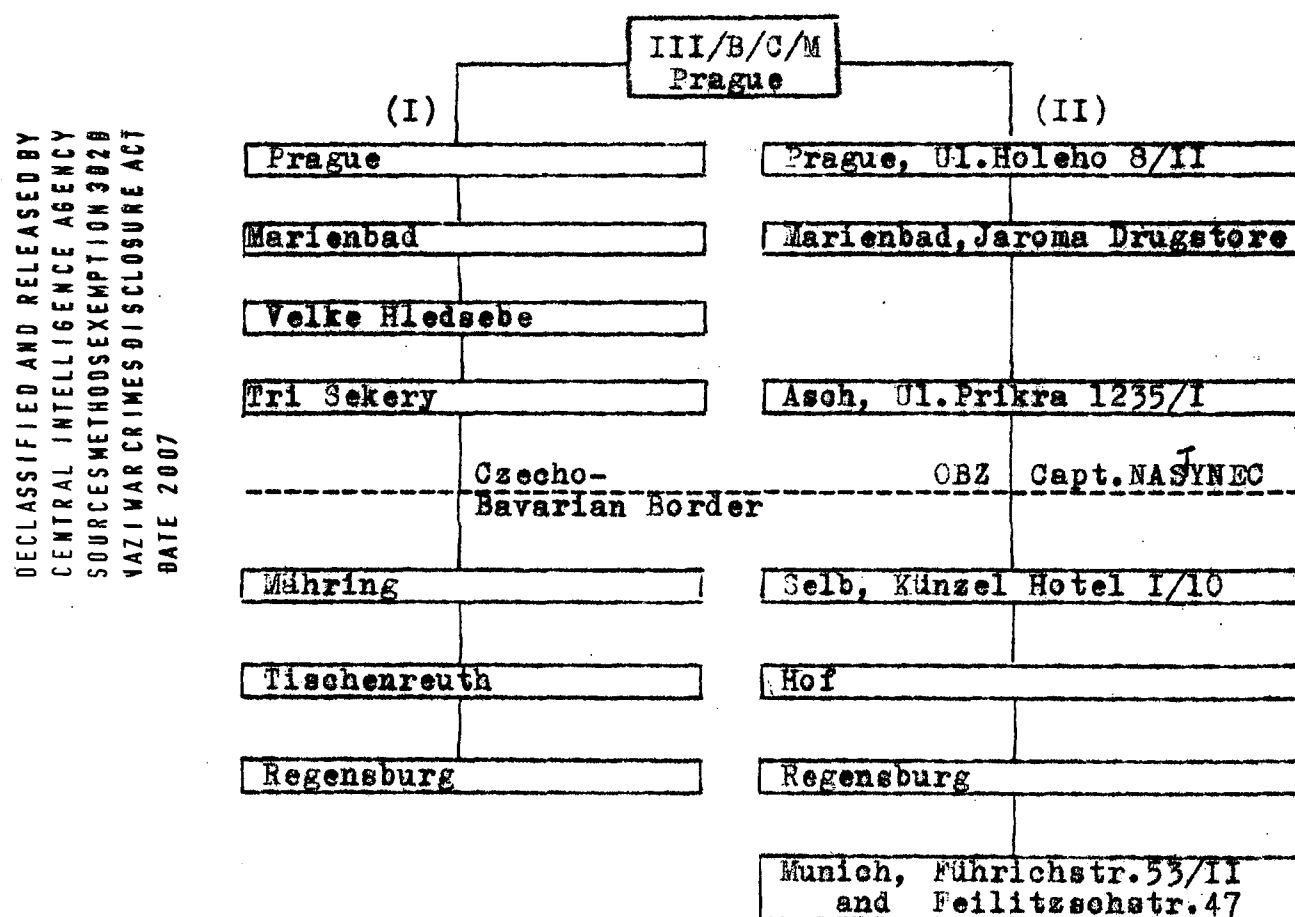

SUBJECT: Agent Line from the III/B/C/M in Prague to its Bunkers in Regensburg and in Munich (Bunker I/B-P/5)

1. Schematic Representation:



2. Already in 1945 the III/B/C/M in Prague had organized an "agent line" for its expansion plans into Germany. It was through this "line" that the Prague Base sent its agents into Bavaria, sent its couriers for regular contact with the despatched agents, and has transmitted and received information and instructions.

3. In January 1946 the III/B/C/M thought up of a special operation for the chief of the established Munich Bunker (I/B-P/5), Andrij PECZARA. This opera-

tion was aimed to accomplish two objectives:

- (a) To enter the UHVR in order to camouflage its own activity under that of the Ukrainian organizations and societies; to use the Ukrainian facilities to dispatch its own agents into any part of the world wherever the Ukrainian emigration goes.
- (b) To penetrate the UHVR; that is to learn all about the UHVR activity and, especially, to learn the details on the UHVR lines of communication with the UPA and Banderovtsi in the Ukraine.

4. The UHVR, though, claims to have thwarted this attempt. The UHVR knew PECZARA and knew that he was in the employ of the SIS. Consequently when he approached the UHVR offering the Ukrainians his support and his facilities "for crossing into Czechoslovakia to Ukraine", the UHVR thought up a plan of its own: The UHVR organized a special UHVR Student Society with Hq. at Munich, Fährichstr. 53/II for PECZARA and his helpers to penetrate. Other Ukrainians innocently joining this organization were not told that it was only a sham organization, but several people were planted in this student organization to observe PECZARA and his helpers. The UHVR also accepted PECZARA's offer to help the UHVR messengers to go into Czechoslovakia; the UHVR sent several people through PECZARA's line, but none were sent into Ukraine; only innocent Ukrainians wishing to visit Czechoslovakia on family business were encouraged to take advantage of PECZARA's offer.

5. It was through this maneuver that the UHVR learned the details reported in MSC 272, 273, 274, 275, 308, the present report, and other reports to come.

6. The referred to PECZARA's "agent line" was roughly represented under §1 of this report. Other details on this "line" follow:

- (a) The starting point in Prague, Ul. Holeho 8/II operates under the direction of one Jurko BISUN, a former Polish-Ukrainian Lt. He is assisted by his brother, Vasil BISUN, by Vasil PAIDA (who is destined to emigrate to the USA through Prague), and by Osip DANKO, who has lately crossed into Bavaria himself and lives as a DP in the Ukrainian DP Camp at Vinsberg, near Ansbach.
- (b) Marienbad, the next point of the "line", uses the services of one JAROMA, a personal friend of PECZARA. JAROMA is a druggist in Marienbad.
- (c) From Marienbad the "line" goes to Asch. The "point" in Asch is located at Ul. Prikra 1235/I. This "point" is directed by one Mychailo OROS. In the past he was assisted by: Fedir GABRIEL (now chief of Bunka G/16 in Ansbach), Jurko DRULAK (now an agent of Bunka CHI/1 in Munich) and "CHORNYJ" (who is now somewhere in the Anzone).

When GABRIEL, DRULAK, and "CZORNYJ" left Asch, OROS got two new helpers: Mykola PUZYK and TURIANYCIA (Ul. Prikra 220, Asch) OROS lives at Ul. Nova 4, in Asch.

- (d) In the actual border crossing the people sent through this "line" were assisted by OBZ Captain NASTYNEC.
- (e) After crossing into Bavaria the people were directed to Selb, Bavaria, Künzel Hotel, where they were received at the 1st floor, room No. 10. They were received at the hotel by PECZARA's friend, one POLDI, a Hungarian national. POLDI's assistant was another Hungarian named Josef LASZLO, who lives in the nearby village of Badershof.
- (f) The next two "points", Hof and Regensburg were never permanent.
- (g) Once the people came to Munich, they were directed to either Jurko DRULAK, Führiehstr. 53/II or to Jurij CHIMINEC, Fellitzschstr. 47.
- (h) This "line" was utilized by more than 80 people, not all of which number are Soviet agents; some of these people paid large sums of money to be able to come to the "Bavarian DP haven". PECZARA's couriers also used the same "line".
- (i) PECZARA tried to bribe the German border guards and also American soldiers to make the crossing less hasardous
- (j) ANOTHER LINE of III/B/C/M leads from Prague through Marienbad, Velke Hledseba, Tri Sekery, Mähring, Tischenreuth, to Regensburg.
