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SUBJECT: Planning of the "LYNX Project" (Report No. 1)

I. This "Project" is to be built around the "LYNX Group", which is the CI section of the UHVR; of MSC 266-271 inclusive.

II. Objective: Utilization of the UHVR contacts and opportunities in order to:

- a. Receive all CI information available to the UHVR people and to their contacts.
- b. Plan to run some of the UHVR agents under our briefing but under the UHVR auspices into Czechoslovakia and into the Polish and Soviet Ukraine.

III. Opportunities offered by the LYNX Group:

- a. Contact with the UPA and Bandera forces and couriers.
- b. Contact with the various Ukrainian nationalist groups whom the UHVR aims to unite and direct.
- c. Contact with the various other nationalist committees with whom the UHVR has a working agreement through its propaganda agency, the ABN.

IV. Disadvantage of our contact with the UHVR: Because through the ABN (Anti-bolsh. Block of Nations) and through the UPS (Ukr. Press Service), the UHVR heavily stresses PROPAGANDA - the UHVR is vulnerable to penetration by the SIS and, therefore, insecure, as our collaborating agency. The only way to make UHVR secure will be by elimination of their Propaganda Section.

V. Preparation for the "LYNX Project":

- a. The LYNX Group was asked to give samples of intelligence available to the UHVR (of MSC 272-275, 308-310).

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- b. Two leaders of the LYNA Group (~~Juril G. TYKALSKI~~ ~~JURKO~~ and ~~Myron MATIJEJKO~~, ~~Stefan JURIK~~ were given a long questionnaire (BO Fragebogen) to fill out.
- c. The LYNA Group will submit some information on the tie-up between the UNVR and the Ukrainian and non-Ukrainian anti-Soviet organizations and national committees.
- d. The LYNA Group will submit all their contacts or attempted contacts with Allied agencies.
- e. The UNVR will cooperate fully with liquidation of AEN's illegal anti-Soviet propaganda section. This "liquidation" has made the following progress:
 1. Vice president of the UNVR and base of the LYNA group has given us his word that dissemination of anti-Soviet propaganda will cease in the American Zone. (This is realized to be a big concession on the part of the UNVR in the interest of our cooperation with UNVR.)
 2. At a meeting with Lt. ~~OSWALD~~ of the Third Army G-2 Section (A.S. 46 in Feldberg), it was discovered that G-2 has been investigating the activity of the Ukrainians and especially of the AEN for the purpose eliminating the illegal propaganda manufacture and dissemination.
 3. At a subsequent meeting with Lt. ~~OSWALD~~ (7 Sept. 1946 in Munich), it was learned that the execution of G-2's plan to eliminate the "illegal propaganda" was in the hands of Col. ~~MONTGOMERY~~, the G-2 of the Second Constabulary Brigade in Munich.
 4. During this meeting also, Lt. ~~OSWALD~~ agreed that G-2 would be fully satisfied if it would manage to (a) locate the place where the propaganda was printed, (b) seize the propaganda material, (c) seize the printing facilities and (d) arrest one or two people responsible for this propaganda for prosecution under IGL Law 191, Para. 1, re "Control of Publications", this material to be used for writing of an "impressive article in the Stars and Stripes".
 5. At an interview with Col. ~~MONTGOMERY~~ (9 Sept. 1946 in Munich) agreement was reached that the G-2 of Second Constabulary Brigade will postpone investigative action into the Ukrainian AEN illegal propaganda until the UNVR is ready for such action to take place.

6. Col. ~~MONROE~~ referred AB-43 to his executive arm, Capt. ~~NOVICKI~~ and Mr. ~~ESKIN~~ of the 427/20 Constabulary CIC, instructing that CIC to "plan investigative action in cooperation with C.I.U."

7. Capt. ~~NOVICKI~~ and Mr. ~~ESKIN~~ were found to be fully cooperative.

8. Vice-president of the UNVR was approached again and agreed to:

- a. Let his propaganda matter be confiscated,
- b. Let some of his printing equipment be seized (possibly to be returned later).
- c. Let "a couple of his people be arrested and charged with violation of MG directive (ICL Law 191, para. 1).
- d. Instruct his people to "make the necessary arrangements "for the official stoppage of ABW propaganda through seizure of material, equipment, and people".

9. COMMENT: This "official liquidation of the ABW propaganda" has been planned to benefit not only the A-2 "LYNA Project" but also to the CI "BWA/CORNA" inasmuch as the UNVR will become under our guidance a more secret and secure group for an American agency to be in touch with.

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
