1. Case Officer met CASSOWARY 15, 12 January 1953, to deliver the December salaries for individuals in our employ.
2. During the conversation CASSOWARY 15 stated that he had recently received a letter from Germany, which stated, that the cashier for the Anti Bolshevik Center in Germany recently departed with 35,000 DM belonging to the Center.
3. Through informants in the New York area, CASSOWARY 2 has received word of the recent formation of a Communist Front Organization called "Committee for Defense of the United Ukraine." This Committee has a plan for waging psychological warfare in the U. S. to counter the work of the American Committee for the Liberation of the Peoples of Russia.
4. CASSOWARY 15 also stated that a conference of the Caucasian Groups was held in Munich at the hotel that DOBRIANSKY was holding his conference, and that this conference was backed by the British. He mentioned the name of Mr. Oberon Herbert.
5. It is believed, by the CASSOWARIES, that this conference was held so as to counter the mission being performed by DOBRIANSKY. After the conference a leaflet was circulated among the Ukrainians in the Munich area to join the Caucasian Group Center.
6. A CE plan is being written by CASSOWARY 1, which will be delivered to the Case Officer in the near future for evaluation and comments.
7. Since CASSOWARY 15 had to go to New York to deliver monies received, the Case Officer requested that a contact be layed on for Thursday, 15 January 1953, so ^{that} he could again be debriefed of any new information he may obtain during his trip.
