SUBJECT: Meeting with AECASSOWARY 15

- 1. The undersigned met with AECASS 15 in order to give him \$1400.00 to be used by AECASC 2 in his trip to Rome and Switzerland. Other than this, the following topics were discussed: a) Informed CASS 15 that we received word from Muni that CASS 3 would be in Rome on 27-29 May and desired to see CASS 2 ther on these dates. Advised him that cable sent to Muni te Ring CASS 3 that CASS 2 would try to make this meeting but in the event he could not, that CASS 3 was to wait at Bucsko's in Rome a day or so longer. CASS 15 said he would convey this information to CASS 2 so he could begin preparations for the trip. CASS 15 said he would go to NYeither on the 27 or 28, depending on when CASS 2 was to depart.
- 2. Brought ink and paper to be ued in writing to Carthage 12. CASS 15 said the letter we intended to write would have have to wait until Tues. June 1 since he planned on remaining in NY over the Memorial Holiday.
- 3. Asked CASS 115 to furnish me with a progress report of the Study Group, which request I had made several weeks ago. This he said he would do. Also asked him to check on the house for the RANTER project. Told him to remind CASS2 to have Shirline inform us when CASS 2 would return, filght No. date, etc. so I could arrange for someone from the Immigration Office to meet him in the event there arose some question re his entry etc.
