SUBJECT: Meeting with AECASS 2

1. AECASS 2 arrived in Wash on 23 Feb. and left for NY on the 25th.

While in Wash Aerodynamic CO<sup>1D</sup> discussed the following with him:

a) Plan for balloon leaflet drops into the Ukraine in the next month or so. Here, AECass 2 was told that facilities were arranged whereby about 15 balloons would be allocated for Uke use in dropping leaflets. Cass 2 was told to prepare sample leaflet scripts (about 15), several of which, or all perhaps, would be selected for use in the drop.

b) Was told that approval was given by Archie R. to do ahead with the radio broadcasts. Cass 2 was told that he and Cass 15 would be given the opportunity of meeting [ ] Roster in order to get an idea of how to construct a technically correct tape, etc. Following this, he was told to make several sample scripts, which when approved, would serve as an example for future scripts.

c) Was told that approval was granted to CO to request support for the ZCHOUN (to be given to ZP allotment from whom the ZChOUN would then borrow), but that first it would have to be determined how much and for how long the British would support the ZChOUN. In the meantime, Cass 2 was told to advise the Suchasna to help the Samostyynik as much as possible until our support was given.

d) Was asked to sign the income tax deduction form where by the Agency would withhold tax. This he refused to do because he did not want to consider himself an employee of the agency (or feared this might become known) but instead preferred to be affiliated as a member of his group for which we give overall support.

e) He asked us to check with immigration and naturalization re his sister's quest for citizenship papers (his sister used a false name once which she did not report prior to coming to the States.)
