SUBJECT: Renewal of Project ANNOUT

1. It is requested that Project ABROCT be renewed retroactively for the period 1 April 1958 to 31 January 1959. This extension is requested to cover the funds that have been spent or obligated under ABROCT for the period 1 April 1958 to 30 September 1958, and to provide funds for the redirection or termination of two agents who will be active after 30 September 1958. The Project will be terminated by 31 January 1959.

2. Background:

Project AEROCT was first approved in March 1953 as AERASIN/FI as a roof project. The cryptonym was changed to AEROCT in August 1953. The original project was designed to support BEDSCK activity into INEMPITY 1. The Project was renewed in June 1955 and again on 6 July 1957. The last renewal covered the period from 1 Hovember 1956 to 31 March 1958. This last renewal also redirected the Project to support HEMEKIE operations against INEMPITY 1.

- 3. Reference: EGFA 23123 dated 20 August 1958.
- 4. Objective:

The objective of the AEROCT Project under the last renewal was to establish resident agents in IMENTITY 1 through REMEKIN operations. In view of the failure of the Project to obtain its objective, a critical review of the Project was made by Headquarters. The review indicated that the agents under the Project should either be terminated or redirected in their efforts. The objective of the Project during this renewal period is to provide for the termination or redirection of the agent personnel of the AEROCT Project.

- 5. Summary of AEROOT activity during the period 1 Hovember to 1 July 1958:
 - a. Recruited and partially trained ARMEON/21 for a repairiation mission to IDENTITY 1.
 - b. Contacted a member of the Soviet Trade Delegation in Bast Berlin through AERCOT/5.
 - c. Sent ANNEON/24 to IDENTITY 2 to contact and assess an old friend of his who was stationed in the Soviet Rubessy there.

The following agent personnel are presently active in the AMOST Project:

- a. AMMENTA/16 is a Baltic German. Operational approval C-53567 was granted 1% December 1956. He has under one trip to the UMAR on a merchant vessel. He will be transferred to a separate project.
- b. AERCOT/5 is the editor of an emigro INERTITY 1 newspaper in Heat Germany. Operational approval C-35273
 was granted 1 June 1955. He will be continued in the two-deat until 31 January. If his performance during the next five months indicates that he can be successfully used as a MEMBELH apotter, the field will prepare a separate project to cover his settivities. If his performance does not warrant continuation of his secretors, he will be terminated before 31 January 1958.
 - newspaper. Operational assistant on AEROCE/5's newspaper. Operational approval C-61883 was granted to Mayob 1958. Since he works under AEROCE/5's experiention, his termination or redirection will be decided absolutions.
- d. ARRECT/24 is an immerser 1 emigre residing in West Germany. Operational approval G-62656 was granted E3 January 1958. He receives no regular salary. He former friend of his who is now stationed in the ARRECT/24 will be financed either through Division dereitopmental funds or through a separate project written around his motivities.
 - e. AERCOR/8 is an INMERIEF I resident of Ireland, employed as a emptain or first mate on ocean going vessels. Operational approval G-ARIO7 was granted to September 1976. He receives no selary. Any operations which thereing from his activities will be financed either expansed Mytelon developmental funds or through a separate project.
- !. The following personnel have been terminated:
- A. AMBOOK/7 was an IMMETRY 1 resident in West Carmany.
 He has emigrated to the United States and is no longer of operational interest to the Project. He was terrainated 14 April 1957.

- c. ARMECM/19 is an IMEMPITY 1 resident in West Germany.

- d. AERECE/21 is an IDENTITY 1 emigre residing in Germany.
 Operational approval C-68656 was granted 21 January
 1958. Since he declined the mission, he was terminated
