10. The Central School will be kept completely separate from the overt NTS structure, knowledge of its existence will not be made known to NTS members, and the senior NTS instructor at the school will be directly subordinate to G. S. Okolovich.
11. All NTS recruiting in the U.S. will be done for the NTS Cadre School. No NTS member may become a candidate for the Central School until he has completed the cadre school. Prior to assignment to the Central School, the American Service must assess and approve the candidate.

PART II - Direction of Operations Within the USSR

1. The direction of operational activities of NTS personnel in the USSR will be guided by the principles laid down in Plan "KARKAS"
2. The direction of these activities will be the joint responsibility of NTS and the American Service.
3. The maintenance and security of W/T communications with NTS personnel in the USSR is the sole responsibility of the American Service.
4. The day-to-day handling of W/T traffic will be carried out by the senior NTS instructor and the senior American instructor attached to the Central School.
5. All logs, messages, copies, etc., pertaining to the W/T traffic will be held by the American Service for reasons of security. This material will be made available to the responsible NTS officer for his inspection upon request.
6. G. S. Okolovich will be kept informed of the progress of the operation by the senior NTS instructor at the Central School.
7. In the event that NTS members who will operate in the USSR are to be provided with either contacts inside or addresses abroad to be used in letter S/W correspondence, the American Service must be informed in sufficient time to run security checks on these individuals.
