SUBJECT: GENERAL- REDSOX/CACCOLA

SPECIFIC- Transfer of the CACCOLA 1 School to the United States

Reference: EGMA-3720

1. Conversations held with the legal and medical authorities at Headquarters have disclosed that the suggestions contained in the referenced dispatch are feasible, but that there are some limitations in the use of Public Law 110 and Section 203 of Public Law 414.

2. The decision that CAPABLE 14 would be brought to the United States with the CACCOLA 1 school presents difficulties which must be resolved. These concern his health and his position as representative of CAPABLE 7. The opinion of the legal counsel is that the poor condition of CAPABLE 14's health--described in the reports of his medical examinations--may prejudice or prevent his entry under Public Law 110, or any other legal means of entry. The possibility that he might suddenly become infectious or completely incapacitated would endanger the health of every person in contact with him and would present a difficult disposal problem. It was agreed, however, that his entry may be possible under the present interpretation of Public Law 110, although there is no guarantee that his entry will be allowed by the approving authorities at Headquarters. If entry is effected we must be prepared to dispose of him in a sanatorium here, or preferably in Europe, in the event that he becomes infectious or completely incapacitated. His movement within the country would be restricted to obviate possible examination and resultant commitment to a sanatorium by a non-KUBARK physician should CAPABLE 14 suddenly fall ill while away from the training site.

3. Headquarters will make every effort to effect the entry of CAPABLE 14 and in order to accomplish this will require the following additional information:

A. A medical re-examination of CAPABLE 14 is obligatory. On the basis of this examination the field medical authorities must be prepared to certify that CAPABLE 14's tuberculosis is both inactive and

stable. It is realized that CAPABLE 14 may be reluctant to enter the hospital again and that the medical examination may have to be delayed until after the dispatch of the present CACCOLA agents. When this certification is received the Headquarter's medical authorities will determine whether CAPABLE 14's entry can be authorized.

B. Detailed justification for support of our assertions that this man is necessary:

- (a) To insure the best training and highest motivation of our agents; and,
- (b) To help assure the continued success of our operations.

4. It must be emphasized that we cannot be optimistic about CAPABLE 14's immigration. If there is another man who can replace CAPABLE 14 without disruption of our present successful cooperation with CAPABLE 1, he should be recruited and prepared to take over.

5. The minimum time estimated for processing of this case is two months after receipt of a Covert Security Clearance. If all the materials requested are available, this lead time may be reduced to some extent.

6. Section 203 of Public Law 414 has not yet been sufficiently tested to make factual statements concerning its use for our purposes since the law was designed primarily for the immigration of professionals, engineers, technicians, and other specialists. At present, each KUBARK case is considered on its merits and if satisfactorily supported will receive the approval of the Attorney General.

7. In order to effect most expeditiously the black entry of agent candidates, all agent candidates' biographical and assessment dispatches should be explicitly slugged REDSOX/CACCOLA. If this is done, priority action can be taken on all phases of the clearance processes in order to obtain the earliest receipt of operational and Covert Security clearances.
