<p>Action Reported by the Field: (Based on February REPORTS & ANNUAL Progress reports, REPORTS for REPORTS, and on cables and dispatches received for the reporting period).</p> <p>1. In comply with German legal requirements, formal action to change the name of REPORTS-1 from REPORTS to REPORTS was completed. The broadcasting action of REPORTS-1 has been a topic of lively speculation and has created favorable comments from the public and dissemination from the masses. In general, the situation was quite favorable and REPORTS-1 should enjoy considerable success.</p> <p>2. REPORTS-1 personnel problems created by migration of key REPORTS-1 are still with us. REPORTS-1 and REPORTS-1 are scheduled to migrate in April. REPORTS-1, the editor of REPORTS-1, has agreed to return to Germany with an REPORTS-1 contract rather than a REPORTS contract. A replacement for REPORTS-1 was found locally and is currently being on-the-job-trained as follows: REPORTS-1 is still involved.</p> <p>3. In view of the success of the Berlin actions conducted by REPORTS-1 among German groups and students and the political favor generated in Berlin for the Berlin radio broadcasts, REPORTS-1 is considering the inauguration of German actions in Berlin. It is felt that this would bring the mass of the organization below local students on the university level.</p> <p>4. Issue No. 3 (37) of REPORTS-1 was printed and distributed during the month. REPORTS-1, the editor of REPORTS-1 called together an editorial committee consisting of REPORTS-1 and others whom we hope to interview in subsequent reports for publication. The two-out was very satisfactory. Issue No. 3 of REPORTS-1, the German language journal was printed and distributed during the month. Five new leaflet texts, prepared by the propaganda writing group and several by REPORTS-1, were submitted for editorial review. Plans are underway to publish in Berlin the second issue of REPORTS-1, "Let by REPORTS-1". This leaflet has already been a hit in the Berlin area and in the West since it was published in serial form in May 56.</p> <p>5. The REPORTS-1 print shop printed 1,000,000 REPORTS-1 leaflet units and REPORTS-1. Other leaflet texts were set and page proofs have been made. The REPORTS-1 action team in Berlin launched a total of 1,300,000 REPORTS-1 leaflet units in 17 different actions. The team has come up with a way to increase the team</p>

capacity for balloons in each nation. By getting hydrogen bottles containing 10 cubic meters instead of the usual six, the volume capacity is increased by two-thirds since the larger bottles are only slightly larger and the same number of bottles can be carried by the truck. The AVTRXIII balloon team in Berlin launched a total of 11,676,463 DIB A-1 Launch units using a total of 2397 balloons. This represents a slight decrease over previous months but reflecting conditions had to be taken into account. In view of peak out load, lift capacity distributed during the past three months has been of a more substantial nature than material inventories distributed. Problems have been the order of the day. In balloons distribution of more substantive lift capacity is worth a qualitative decrease.

6. AVTRXIII succeeded in obtaining the amount of the Spanish officials of Radio broadcasts in Madrid to have an AVTRXIII join the staff of the Russian desk on the radio. AVTRXIII-3 is temporarily in Madrid pending the permanent assignment of AVTRXIII-105, an outage attributed to AVTRXIII when it violated the disability criteria for membership.

General Remarks:
