10. Action Reported by the Field: (Based on March ANVIRILL and ANVIRILL Progress reports, latest yet received, and on cable and dispatch traffic for the reporting period).						
<p>1. Further action on the broadening front of ANVIRILL was taken at the Francidian meeting of 22 March. The protocol of this meeting, containing the names of 16 new members accepted into the organization, was forwarded to Headquarters. Co-opted into the Francidian were ANVIRILL 45, a member of the working group for over a year, and Dr. Connally Smith, a leading figure in the Institute for the Study of the USSR.</p> <p>2. As reported in the March Progress Report, a subject start was made toward expanding ANVIRILL 1's influence on the German scene with a lecture in German entitled "Communism and the Nazis" by Fritz Mauer, editor of the Henschel Mauer. Approximately 50 persons attended.</p> <p>3. ANVIRILL 3 returned from Zurich via Paris where he attended a youth conference sponsored by the European Federalist Union. He also met with several emigres in Paris the possibility of establishing an ANVIRILL 1 Section there.</p> <p>4. It is anticipated that the first copies of the Eulinkov novel, "Not by Bread Alone", will be ready for distribution soon. Six leaflet texts, prepared by the propaganda writing group were prepared for editorial review. Three new brochures have been received from different authors and are awaiting printing.</p> <p>5. The ANVIRILL print shop turned out 3,800,000 DIN A-7 leaflet units during the month in addition to 3,000 copies of a new brochure. A brochure about Howard Fast's break with the Communist party is now being printed. This month setting and page proofs for 7 leaflets were done in the shop. The new chief printer is proving to be quite satisfactory.</p> <p>6. A total of 4,128,700 DIN-A-7 leaflet units were ballooned in 17 actions during the month by the Russia team.</p> <p>7. Leaflet distribution by the ANVIRILL team totaled ^{AND IS THE EQUIVALENT OF} 18,178,100 DIN-A-7 units carried by 2,826 balloons. Principal item distributed was brochures which kept the leaflet count down to 2,050,806 items.</p> <p>General Remarks: A total of 67 indications of ANVIRILL leaflets being found in the field was received during the month. 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the ABCARRERA office who brought in a copy of the Hungarian brochure which he had found in the neighborhood of Koenigsusterhausen on the 4th of March. On that same day he was given a ride in a Soviet jeep and noted that the 3 Soviet soldiers in the jeep had a copy of the same brochure. Another visitor reported the mobilization of Soviet soldiers in Jamberg at the end of February for the collection and destruction of ASVINGIL material.

Security Factors: ASVINGIL 6 infiltrated 28 March and within limits of technique test results indicate no reaction when questioned regarding passing verbal or oral reports HIS postwar or the existence of a present HIS mission, or an unknown pseudo. Reactions were noted when questioned re POST WAR HIS contact. This has not yet been clarified.
