10. Action Reported by the Field: (Based on April AEVIRIIL and AEGACORIL Progress Reports, latest yet received, and on cable and dispatch traffic for the reporting period).						
<p>1. There has been a definite slow-up of the AEVIRIIL broadening action due to a lack of candidates. In Germany attention will now be turned toward building up more of a mass organization. Abroad the best present prospects are for the sections in Belgium and the United States.</p> <p>2. AEVIRIIL-7 arrived in the United States and it is hoped that he will be able to recruit a nucleus around which a live section of AEVIRIIL-53 will eventually develop.</p> <p>3. AEVIRIIL-8 left Munich on 17 April and the AEVIRIILITES have heard that he is happily settled with friends in New York city.</p> <p>4. AEVIRIIL-103 resigned his job in AEVIRIIL-64 effective April 30.</p> <p>5. AEVIRIIL-106 took over as new leader of AEVIRIIL-66 during the month and so far has performed satisfactorily.</p> <p>6. AEVIRIILS 3, 4, 6, 106 and 108 took part in the ARDENAND meeting. In general they pronounced themselves satisfied with the conduct of the meeting and the results which were obtained. The report on the meeting is forthcoming shortly. On 3 May the AEVIRIIL members who had attended the conference reported to other AEVIRIIL members and emigre guests. They reported that this meeting showed that there is much bitter feeling about ARDENAND among the emigres and that they had to defend themselves against the charge of having fallen completely under the influence of SHUSA-100. A complete report on this meeting has not yet been received.</p> <p>7. The AEVIRIIL-1 team at the ARDENAND meeting, with the exception of AEVIRIIL-6, returned via Belgium in order to visit the newly-activated Belgian section of AEVIRIIL-1. Their activities included a press conference, a meeting of the members of the Belgian section and an appearance at the Russian club in Liège.</p> <p>8. The first copies of the Dudintsev novel, "Not by Bread Alone" came off the press toward the middle of the month. Approximately 800 of the 2000 ordered thus far were distributed during the month. The full printing will be 6000 copies of the overt and 1000 of the covert editions.</p>

9. It is felt that since AEVIRGILL-1 is so completely occupied with the Dudintsev novel, the distribution of the Peter Fryer book can best be handled by SHUBA-100.

10. The AEVIRGILL print shop turned out 2,040,000 DIN-A-7 leaflet units during the month in addition to No. 1 of AEVIRGILL 74 and one brochure in 16,000 copies.

11. The April issue of AEVIRGILL-70 was distributed in the middle of the month. The April issue of AEVIRGILL-74 was also distributed during the month.

12. A total of 2,725,150 DIN-A-7 leaflet were ballooned in 13 actions during the month, by the Bavaria team.

13. Leaflet distribution by the AEGACOTOL team totaled and is the equivalent of 11,908,186 DIN-A-7 units carried by 3,394 balloons.

Observed Results:

During the month there was received a total of 96 reports of AEVIRGILL leaflets being found in the DDR. Of special interest is the response to the "Ja oder Nein" leaflet which requested finders to scratch out the appropriate words and return the leaflet. These responses have accounted for a third of these indications of effectiveness.
