- 1. There has been a definite element of the AFVIRITA broadening action due to a lack of condidates. In Corneny attention will now be turned toward building up more of a mess organization. Abread the best present prospects are for the sections in Belgium and the United States.
- 2. APVIROID-7 aspired in the United States and it is hoped that he will be able to recruit a numbers around which a live section of APVIROID-53 will eventually develop
- 3. AEVIROIL-3 left Musich on 17 April and the AEVIROILITES have heard that he is happily sottled with friends in New York city.
 - h. ANVIROID-10h resigned his job in ANVIROID-6h effective April 30.
- 5. ANIANIL-105 took over so new leader of ANIANIL-66 during the month and so for hes performed entisfactorily.

- 11. The April issue of ANVIROIL-70 was distributed in the middle of the month. The April issue of ANVIROIL-7h was also distributed during the month.
- 12. A total of 2,725, 150 DIN-A-7 leaflet were balloomed in 13 actions during the month, by the Bavaria team.
