<p>Action Requested by the Field: (Based on My AVIRIEL Progress Report - latest yet received, and on cables and dispatch traffic for the reporting period).</p> <p>1. AVIRIEL 4 and [redacted] have received encouraging letters from AVIRIEL 7 concerning the progress of his organizational mission in the United States. According to the most recent communication he was to convene a plenary session of AVIRIEL 53 in order to make certain necessary decisions concerning the breaching action.</p> <p>2. V. Grotter paid another visit to the AVIRIELERS during May, the formal purpose of which was to discuss AVIRIEL and assign functions thereto. Informally he continued to press for closer cooperation but with about the same results as previously, that is, no outright refusal but a fairly cool reception.</p> <p>3. On the emigre political front, AVIRIEL continues to be the center of a violent storm. In a 3 May meeting on the AVIRIEL 1 premises the AVIRIEL delegates attempted to explain the Congress to some of the Munich emigre personalities. They were greeted by a sharp, almost violent barrage of criticism. The same thing happened in a long story session of the AVIRIEL 1 premises on 18 May. On 20 May a meeting was convened by an "initiating group" including A. MICHALOWSKI, B. WOLFF, and others in order to develop plans for an emigre movement to counter AVIRIEL. This is said to have been a rather sorry affair, concerning itself with anti-SHARA activity at the lowest emigre level. For the present AVIRIEL 1 is adopting a wait-and-see position with respect to the Congress.</p> <p>4. The new burglar alarm system for the AVIRIEL 1 office is not yet working satisfactorily. It went off twice during the past month with no sign of attempted entry. It is expected that the hook-up to the police station will be completed shortly, thus obviating the need for the siren.</p> <p>5. IS-774 visited Munich during the period 13 through 21 May and made a good impression on the AVIRIELERS. He was subjected to a certain amount of negative propaganda by AVIRIEL but presumably no permanent harm was done. The AVIRIELERS found, however, that the SHARAS had done a pretty good job of preparing IS-774 for his Munich visit, and he seemed at least partly in the SHARAS camp.</p>

6. The Daintsev novel, "Not by Bread Alone" continued to be distributed during May, with a total of 2,200 copies out for sale or free hand-out.
7. Issue No. 5 (59) of AEVIRGIL 70 was distributed in the middle of the month.
8. Approximately 13 leaflet texts were prepared for editorial review.
9. AEVIRGIL 3 produced several texts in Berlin, based on the resolutions of the Hague Congress.
10. The "poor edition" of AEVIRGIL 70 was printed in Frankfurt and forwarded to Berlin and to the Bavarian balloon base. This is now a regular monthly production item.
11. A total of 4,760,650 DIE-A-7 units was ballooned during May, by the Bavaria team.
12. The AEVIRGILITES are beginning to send completed tapes to Furness in accordance with the desires expressed in a recent DCU letter.

Security:

James H. DUNBARDIER was visited in New York City during the month by a Headquarters Case Officer and a clinical psychologist for observation purposes. DUNBARDIER has been preoccupied with the subject of sexual aberrations and he has made some scurrilous and bizarre accusations against some of his former colleagues. Reports of the meeting are currently being circulated among interested parties.
