 - 10. Icane No. 11 of AFVINIL 71 appeared in June not previously reported.
- 11. A total of h, 226,500 DIN A 7 leaflet units was balloomed from the AEVIRGIL 1 Baverian bases in July.

This slogen governs us. There are many young people in Justerbog who would like to do something in the struggle for freedom.

"Perhaps you won't pay attention to my letter generally. However, it is the case, as this letter assures you, that you can count on a large part of the youth of the DR.
