10. <u>Action Requested by the Field:</u>						
<p>1. It should be possible to start legal funding on 1 December, but the Field requests that final action be deferred until they are assured that all the problems connected with the "legal" bookkeeping for AVINIL-1 are resolved.</p> <p>2. The exigencies of AVINIL-1 was discussed personally with HARVARD and the report on the decision which was reached will be reported as soon as possible.</p> <p>3. The technical details of the financial settlement for AVINIL-2 have not yet been arranged. The Field expects clarification of her status as regards eligibility for German welfare payments shortly.</p> <p>4. Final preparations for the celebration of the 10th Anniversary of the Bolshevik Revolution in Berlin were made during the month. There will be an expanded and public session of the AVINIL-1 seminar on 6 November and the AVINIL-1 public meeting on 7 November. Both will be held in the new Hauptstadt and the latter meeting will include representatives of German, Hungarian, Bulgarian and Polish organizations as speakers.</p> <p>5. Locally the AVINIL-1 action will include active participation in the traditional "Day of Irreconcilability" and in another "international meeting" sponsored by FRONTE.</p> <p>6. The Field is well pleased with the start of the Belgian chapter and closer contact with the group will be one of the first things on the agenda as the November meetings and press conference are concluded.</p> <p>7. Due to the double number of AVINIL-70 distributed late last month, there was no October issue. Issue No. 11 will be distributed early in November, Issue No. 12 of AVINIL-70 was distributed at the end of the month.</p> <p>8. Two leaflet texts were prepared for editorial review and issue 6-110 of the "poor edition" of AVINIL-70 together with an additional leaflet was sent to Frankfurt for printing by METOPAS. Discussions with METOPAS during the month established that the sum for the "poor edition" of AVINIL-70 can be doubled from the present \$20,000 if we eliminate the need for folding which is done by the same printer and which takes as much time as the printing itself. They will have to consider doing this in order</p>

to supply the needs of the AEGACOTOL balloon team from Munich, if, as appears probable this becomes necessary.

9. The AEVIRGIL shop printed 6,340,000 DIN-A-7 leaflet units during the month in addition to 3,500 copies of AEVIRGIL-7h. It will be noted that this is far better than any previous month. This testified to the proficiency of the present printer and the diligence of the print shop as a whole.

10. A total of 5,161,450 DIN-A-7 leaflet units were ballooned in 15 actions during the month by the AEVIRGIL balloon team. Despite the general difficulty with the procurement of hydrogen AEVIRGIL-108 appears able to continue to get hydrogen for both the AEVIRGIL-1 and the AEGACOTOL teams.

11. The current report for the period 20 August to 30 September. During the reporting period the AEGACOTOL team ballooned a total of 13,105,363 DIN-A-7 units carried in 3,465 balloons.
