9. 3,000 copies of Issue #12 (66) of "SVOBODA" were distributed early in December and Issue #1 (67) came off the press at the end of the month.

10. 3,500 copies of Issue #14 of "DER ARTI-KOMMUNIST" were distributed in mid-December.

11. Due to the lack of ballooning capability during the month, only one Russian language leaflet was printed, in the amount of 1,430,000 Din-A-7 units.

12. On the evenings of 24 and 25 December unsuccessful attempts were made to break into the ANVIRGIL-1 office through the celler. Both times the intruders escaped when the police arrived. No further details are available.

13. During the evening of 7 November the small warehouse used by the AECACOTOL belloon team in Schoeningen was broken into.
