SUMMARY - AEVIRGIL CONTACT OPERATIONS

Post Brussels Fair - June 1959

9/58	Munich	Track and field team	Gave them shopping money, helped shop Brief discussions.
9/58	Munich	Byzantine specialists (2 women)	Not very successful, Soviets under close watch by their officials, but gave copy of <u>Dr. Zhivago</u> .
10/58	Munich	Soviet students meeting with German students	At first the German students much opposed to AEVIRGIL contacting visitors, but VIRGILite convinced German leader, talked some with Soviet students. Reported that it is easier to take in <u>Dr. Zhivago</u> , etc., through Finland.
12/58	Munich	Czech, Polish heavyweight team	Excellent discussions, in cooperatio with AEGIDEON gave <u>Dr. Zhivago</u> , other literature. One Czech promised to tak literature with him when he went to Moscow in March.
		Soviet hockey team	Little success, close guarded by nursemaids.
2/59	Munich	Polish exchange student	Visited home of AEVIRGILite, compatib discussions, no literature given out.
26/2/59	Munich	Hockey team	Little success.
3/59	Israel	Thirteen Soviet seamen	Requested them to help distribute AEVIRGIL literature, reportedly successful, but have no followup here.
6/59	Belgium	Soviet tourists	No report received here yet on this operation.

1 through 3/59 AECARRERA 48 visitors, 17 first-time East Germans.

4 through 6/59 AECARRERA 50 visitors, 16 first-time East Germans.

In January and in April 1959 AEVIRGILites from Munich traveled to the Kiel-Lubeck area to investigate contact possibilities among Soviet seamen there. Reports seem rather discouraging as to prospects.
