1. Transmitted by alternate pages under separate cover is a copy of the AEVIRGIL Renewal for FY 1961, approved by KUBOVÉ on 1 March 1961.
2. Headquarters very much appreciated the timely responses from MOG and information addressees in reply to our request for renewal support information. As you will note, all facts submitted were included in the renewal document.
3. Headquarters is particularly gratified by the recent MOG attempts to increase the operational potential of AEVIRGIL through the training program, increase of mailing operations, and strengthening of discipline within the organization itself. As Munich is aware, the immediate future of AEVIRGIL may well depend upon the success of these attempts.
4. We should also like to express our appreciation to MOG for its thorough and timely reporting on AEVIRGIL developments. In this regard, however, we might stress the importance of the AEVIRGILITES themselves reporting on their contact operations and literature distribution. Although we realize that getting such reporting is easier said than done, these are two aspects of AEVIRGIL activity on which Headquarters officers have almost no information and on which they are most often queried.
5. It is requested that all addressees forward to Headquarters by 1 July a status report on the AEVIRGIL activity within their area during the previous year. We know that there may not be a great deal new to report at that time since the previous reports were forwarded in December; however, this year Headquarters would like to submit the FY 1962 Renewal for AEVIRGIL when it is actually due--in the summer of 1961.
