MEMORANDUM TO: Office of Security

Category A. Members of AEVIRGIL 1 and Employees of the Organization who are in key positions and (a) are witting of ODYOKE support of AEVIRGIL or (b) have contact with CIA case officers or (c) have access to classified information.

We now hold full operational clearances on these individuals and will continue this practice.

1. AEVIRGIL 6 (C-49551) chairman of the organization - a, b, and c above hold true.
2. AEVIRGIL 5 (C-14047) deputy chairman of the organization - a, b, and c above hold true.
3. AEVIRGIL 109 (C-60850) chief bookkeeper, not a member of the organization - witting of ODYOKE support, no case officer contact.
4. AEVIRGIL 108 (C-52667) chief of the AEVIRGIL balloon team, not a member of TsOPE, does not have case officer contact.
5. AECADARZO (C-26218) employee of AEVIRGIL, works as interviewer, not a member of TsOPE but a, b, and c above hold true.

Category B. Members of AEVIRGIL 1 and Employees of the Organization who are not witting of ODYOKE support of AEVIRGIL 1, have no contact with case officers nor (c) have access to classified information.

1. FISCHER, Erick graphics artist and designer, does occasional work for AEVIRGIL in connection with their publications.
2. AEVIRGIL 110 ~~(C-60865)~~ draftsman and printer in the AEVIRGIL print shop holds proprietary approval # 158362.
3. ZVI, Gregory AEVIRGIL member in Israel, distributes overt AEVIRGIL literature.
