: Discussion with G-2 on the Ludwig ALBERT Case

ACTION REQUIRED: See paragraph 1.

1. Under separate cover we are sending to ULS, a brief summary of our discussion of 10 June with G-2 on the ALBERT case. It is requested that ULS pass G-2 this summary which we trust will serve to remind them of their agreement to give KUBARK their information on ALBERT. Naturally, the sooner we get it the better.

2. [ ] and the undersigned of POB, [ ] of COS, [ ] of ULS and Mr. Donald Kempf and Captain Kincaid of G-2 met on June 10 in Seidelberg to discuss Subject. The discussion was held along lines suggested in reference. In general, [ ] outlined KUBARK's interest and need in obtaining G-2's information. As used as a basis for his presentation, the several points he examined in the study of UPSWING security. This study was transmitted via ROLA-23180.

3. The G-2 reaction was, we believe, favorable, particularly since they felt called upon to emphasize their opinions regarding UPSWING security. There was no disagreement from any quarter that UPSWING's security was of material concern to PRIME interests in Germany, and with this principle established, it was wholly logical that G-2 should accede to [ ] request for their data on ALBERT.

4. We do not venture to predict just how such information will be forthcoming. G-2's representatives at the meeting took the line that ALBERT's reporting on UPSWING was merely incidental, that he was little more than a casual sub-source, and that they really were not sure where all the material presently reposes. The Subject - to them - was so dead that neither Kempf nor Kincaid could express detailed knowledge of ALBERT's work.

work. Since they agreed to start a search for the material and to forward it to us when it is found, [ ] did not deem it pertinent to our purpose to point out certain misconceptions the gentlemen from G-2 seemed to be laboring under. Nevertheless, he took the occasion of this meeting to enlighten them on various other aspects of KUBARK-IPS-ING relations on which they were either not clear or misinformed. We will possibly have to indulge in occasional prods to get the promised G-2 reports, but when they are forthcoming, we believe they will prove useful and informative.

5. [ ] no doubt will provide Headquarters with a more complete run down on this general topic since he has now returned to Washington, DC.
