SUBJECT : ALT's Areas of Interest for DTR's FE Trip

concluded in memo to DTR 9 Feb 72

1. What ALT needs more than anything else is some advertising. Let us recommend that the DTR dust off his best Madison Avenue manners during his trip. Advertising on two counts, I think: first, so that Stations and Bases will be aware of ALT's existence and purposes, and; second, so that capable CS officers will learn that a two-year or longer hitch as an ALT training officer is a most interesting assignment (join ALT and see the world).
