"Dr. Erich RAFFEL, Pol. Kommissar, born 12 July 1926 in Vienna, Austria, married, member of the Augsburg Branch of the Evangelical Church and a Resident of Salzburg, Ignaz Harrer Strasse either 48e or 52 (one house). He is the Deputy Chief of the Stapo. His parents are Leopold and Stefan (sic). He has been in Salzburg since 1 August 1951. He is a member of the Bund der Sozialistischen Akademiker. His political orientation is Socialist. He was placed in his present job because of socialist pressure from the police in Vienna. He is conscientious. He was allegedly with a flak unit in Vienna toward the end of the war. He first received his doctor's degree while in Salzburg from the law faculty of the University of Innsbruck. [] commented that the occupant of the deputy chief's chair is frequently changed".
