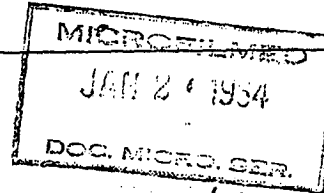

was apparently his case officer. Our latest trace on ANGERER is from 1961. In January of that year ODOPAL traced Subject with all agencies in Germany and KUBARK Austria for CIIL. At that time CATIDE answered to our request for traces: "CATIDE has contact with Subject and requests that you make no contact".

is meager indeed. We have no record of her under that first name but Munich files contain a possible identity. We have a card on a Gretel STRASSER as the sister of Eleanore SPARRER; "approximately 27, owns with her husband a small cafe in Teising". The file number given is A 359/54 filed O-4h. The first part of the number is meaningless for present Munich registry purposes, but the O-4h might refer to the old OKAPI operation. In that case O-4h leads us to a document number MGKA 12383, but we do not have the document. Maybe COS or RI can locate a copy and determine whether it refers to the Margarethe STRASSER of Reference.

3. Munich files has no other information on Subjects.
