09.30 - 11.30 hrs.

I met Irena P. in the city at the place we have previously agreed. The purpose of the meeting was to recruit Irena for spotting tourists from Latvia and Lithuania, offering her payment for her services.

Apart from the conversation on subjects which were of no importance for our work, I proposed to her at one point to cooperate with me in spotting and contacting Soviet tourists during the period from Aug 25 till Sep 10, 1960. For this job she would get a payment of 2,500.00 liras per day. Transportation expenses would be reimbursed extra. Her task would be to frequent according to a schedule yet to be worked out places where Soviet tourists could be expected to appear. I told her, that if she would be willing to cooperate with me on such a basis, I would give her detailed instructions later. Having listened to this proposal of mine, subject told me sincerely, that she does not like such a job. However, she asked me to wait until the next day, Aug 24, when she would give me her final answer.

On my part I asked her not to speak to anybody about this conversation of ours, so that no one else would know it. She readily promised that to me.
