services <sup>as a result of his knowledge</sup> ~~through~~ his operational activities ~~and~~

and c) Delator 1 has had  
direct contact with at least one  
member of the Soviet Embassy in Germany

and d) Delator 1 has twice  
reacted to ~~several~~ "hot" questions posed

on LC FLUTTER examination although not  
specifically to questions concerning ~~his~~ present R.I.S. contact.

and e) Delator 1 ~~has been~~  
on anonymous with  
denounced <sup>as</sup> to Cavata as an R.I.S.  
agent (see BON 14 9149)

and f) Johannes Mueller, a  
close <sup>personal</sup> friend and <sup>Delator 1's</sup> former Abwehr  
chief, is <sup>one of</sup> the targets of an R.I.S.

Any single one of these factors, <sup>when considered independently</sup> might be ~~not considered~~ ~~insignificant~~ but

when they are considered as a unit

~~the~~ <sup>the</sup> potential ~~to see~~ security

implications cannot be overemphasized.

Defector 1 Visit to the United States

Little or nothing appears in the Headquarters' file apart from the bare statement that Defector 1 visited the United States during July 1959. Did he travel alone? How did he travel? Where did he obtain sufficient funds to enable him to make the trip? Did he visit his mother and daughter in the United States? Did he make other contacts ~~en route~~ en route or while here? Did he visit any other relatives here or any of his old military

buddies? Headquarters knows nothing  
about the contacts whom Alicker  
reports <sup>in his PRQ Part 1 as</sup> living in the United States and,  
in the expectation that these were the  
individuals whom Subject visited, Headquarters  
is tracing the names and running summary  
checks on them. The Field will be  
advised of the results when they are  
obtained.

## Operational Files

Unfortunately the reporting of the  
Deletor 1's operational activity leaves  
much to be desired. The Headquarters'

files indicate large gaps between August  
1958 and August 1959 and between

September 1959 and August 1960. This

may be partially a bureaucratic or  
administrative oversight but whatever

the cause, it seriously complicates

~~any~~ our evaluation of the Deletor 1 case.

There is, for example, no single history

of Delator 1's operational contacts. Although  
Subject was apparently <sup>recruited for and</sup> active in the  
returnee - debriefing program and the  
Redskin spotters program, the <sup>deliator</sup> file  
~~kept~~ <sup>with a</sup> contains a single debriefing report  
not a favorable Redskin assessment.

The files indicate that Subject had operational  
contact with: a) Wanda Peters, who admitted  
to the German police that she had been recruited  
as an accommodation address by Deliator 1 @
