In compliance with a request made in paragraph 2 of Reference, we have gathered together the raw reports (contact reports in Lithuanian) of AELICTOR 1 and are transmitting them under separate cover to this dispatch as Attachment A. Meldeamt checks were made on a few of the individuals in which cases such residence checks are attached. Other pertinent papers are also included on some of the people, e.g., Vytautas BRASSAT. As you will observe, working notes — made at the time the reports were submitted — have been penned on some of the reports, e.g., "too old," "unsuitable," and so on. You will also note that in some cases individuals have been mentioned in previous dispatches to Headquarters. In every case nothing further is to be found in the Soviet Branch on any of the persons and for FOB's part, interest in any of them ceases with the dispatch of Attachment A. We leave it to SRs discretion whether or not the names should be carded.

3. Also requested in paragraph 2 of Reference is the "master list of individuals whom he (AELICTOR 1) contacted." Several lists of names appear in AELICTOR 1's file, one of which — written by [] — may well be the "master list" to which Headquarters refers as it contains a number of the names listed above. In addition to this, however, are several other lists — "Leads not yet contacted," and various lists which appear to be internal addressees which were probably utilized in conjunction with AELICTOR 1's KUCAGE activities. All of these lists are being forwarded under separate cover as Attachment B.

4. For your information there are a number of texts for use in the KUCAGE letter writing program contained in AELICTOR 1's file. Although we are retaining the former agent's file at FOB because of Headquarters request to maintain intermittent contact with AELICTOR 1, the several themes used in the past for propaganda letters are now outdated and of no further value in KUCAGE letter writing activities. These working papers of texts and themes are therefore being destroyed.
