2. [Redacted] THE 601ST INTELLIGENCE BATTALION, THE OPERATIONAL ARM OF THE
ARMY INTELLIGENCE SERVICE (SIE), MET WITH [Redacted]
[Redacted] THE FEDERAL POLICE TO DISCUSS WAYS OF PREVENTING
FURTHER REVELATIONS OF EXCESSES DURING THE "DIRTY WAR"; THE
PARTICIPANTS IN THE MEETING HAD PARTICIPATED IN ACTIONS BY
THEIR SERVICES DURING THAT PERIOD. [Redacted] THE FEDERAL
POLICE DESCRIBED THEIR WILLINGNESS TO CARRY OUT VIOLENT
ACTIONS, IF NECESSARY, TO IMPRESS THE GOVERNMENT WITH THE
LEVEL OF THEIR CONCERN OVER THEIR PERCEIVED LACK OF
PROTECTION FOR ACTIONS DURING THE "DIRTY WAR". [Redacted]
601ST BATTALION AGREED THEY SHOULD REESTABLISH THE GROUPS
THAT OPERATED DURING THE "DIRTY WAR"; THEY ALSO AGREED

B. THE STATEMENTS AND ACTIONS DESCRIBED IN THIS REPORT ALL OCCURRED BEFORE THE JUNTA ISSUED ITS "FINAL REPORT" ON THE "DIRTY WAR" ON THE EVENING OF 28 APRIL. THE REACTION OF THE ARGENTINE PUBLIC TO THAT REPORT HAS BEEN ALMOST UNIFORMLY NEGATIVE, AND ITS PUBLICATION IS NOT LIKELY TO REDUCE THE LEVEL OF CONCERN AMONG SECURITY AND POLICE PERSONNEL WHO PLAYED A PERSONAL ROLE IN THE ACTIVITIES OF THE "DIRTY WAR".)
