ARTICHOKE Conference, 24 September 1953.

1. On Thursday, 24 September 1953, between 2:10 PM and 3:45 PM, an ARTICHOKE Conference was held in the SO Conference Room, 2065 I Building. Present at this Conference were Mr. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED], representing SO; Dr. Sidney Gottlieb representing TSS; [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] representing the Medical Staff; and [REDACTED] representing DDP.
