SUBJECT:	Assessmen	t of	Applicants	for	OPC	Training	Staff	

- 1. It is considered essential to a joint CSO/OPC training program that persons being considered for employment on the training staffs of either office be given the same type of screening and assessment, with final decision, of course, resting with the office of employment.
- 2. OSO applicants are presently assessed by TRS/OSO by means of a series of intelligence tests and an interview with Dr. William J. Morgan based on the results of the tests. This program occupies a day or a day and a half, and has proved invaluable in ascertaining the abilities and possibilities of applicants.
- 3. It is understood that TRS/OSO is willing to give OPC candidates similar treatment in view of the fact that if employed they will be instructing and servicing OSO students. It is suggested, therefore, that ADPC request ADSO that when feasible OPC candidates be assessed by TRS/OSO. instructor
