# BÜHLE, Hans von

Counsellor of German Embassy, Berne. Chief of N.S.D.A.P. or perhaps principal agent of Von Ribbentrop Bureau, succeeding Friedrich von Eibrag.

# BERG, Freiherr Ernst Sigismund von

1939-40 head of Gestapo in Switzerland. November 1942, directing intelligence at Consulate, Zurich, Waldreidstrasse, 25, Burib, near Berne.

# DETTWYLER, from [unclear]

Swiss. May be identical with Dettwyler, French agent at Amecasse during last war. 1941 directing German sabotage in Switzerland. Head of "Satus", Swiss Sports Organization.

# DERNBACH, (Major)

Germany. In charge of counter-espionage section of German High Command Intelligence Station at Angers up to April, 1941. Now supposedly in Switzerland.

# ENGELBRECHTEN, Baron Max von

Press Attache at German Consulate, Geneva. Red Cross Representative to Prisoners of War, Geneva, central agency. Believed to be head of German I.S. in Geneva. In close touch with Abwehr, Stuttgart. Address, Villa Chemin de l'Escotade, Geneva.

# FINKENBERG, (Graf) Hans Wolfram

Germany. Reported to have been head of Gestapo in Geneva. In touch with Karl Gelpke.

# GELPKE, Karl

Germany. A place du Grand Mezel, Geneva. Chief of Gestapo, Geneva, working from German Consulate. President of Deutscher Kriegerverein Geneva.

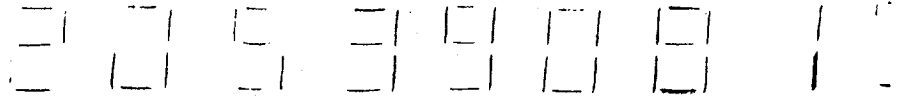
# GR.F, Gerhard

Germany. Vice Consul, Zurich, head of Gestapo. Address, Schiedhaldenstrasse, 39 Zurich.

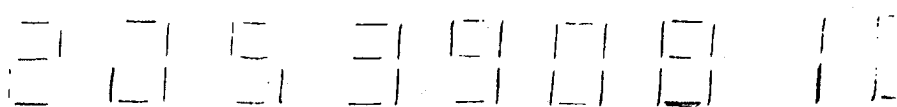

LEADERS OF GERMAN INTELLIGENCE

- # HEINTSCHEL, (Dr.) O.T. Germany <sup>A</sup> Avenue des Perolles, Fribourg, in charge of German I.S.
- # HOHENLORFF, Horst O.T. Germany In charge of German I.S. Lausanne, attached to Consulate, Head of German Students organization in Switzerland.
- # KLINENFELSS, Karl O.T. Germany <sup>A</sup> Hotel Bristol, Berne, attached to German Legation. Replaced Dr. Asten. Chief S.S. Agent, sent to assist von Hibr.
- # RUDY, (General) O.T. Germany 1936, reported to be controlling all German agents in Locarno and North Italy.
- # KURTH, Hans Josef (alias FREY, <sup>@H</sup> FRIE or ARJCH) O.T. Germany <sup>A</sup> 451 Rue de Geneve, Lausanne. Also, Villa Chaumont, 13 Rue Bellevue, Monte Carlo. Head of German I.S. For Eastern Mediterranean, employed in ~~Central Consulate, Switzerland~~.
- # LEBLANC, Herbert E. O.T. Germany Bank representative. Said to be head of Nazi organization, Geneva. <sup>Swiss, Swedish, awarded badge of National League of Nations</sup>
- # LEONHARD, Oberst O.T. Germany Naturalized German (Swiss by birth). Head of German I.S. Switzerland, March 1940. May be identical with "Doctor" of Bund Treuer Eidgenossen <sup>espionage case</sup>.
- # LIPPE, (Freiherr) Viktor von der O.T. Germany Attached to German Consulate, Geneva, press and propaganda section. Reported head of German I.S. Geneva.
- # MAYER, (Dr.) Otto Eberhard O.T. Germany <sup>A</sup> Hotel Trois Ruis, Basel. Attached to German Consulate, directing Auslandorganisation. Nov. 1942, said to be in charge of I.S. Basel.
- # MEISSNER, <sup>(Lt. Col.)</sup> Korvettenkapitän Hans O.T. Germany <sup>A</sup> Gutenbergstrasse, 39, Berne. Head of I.S. Berne as Consul General at Legation. Personally directs counter-espionage.

- # JURLEN, Hauptmann von und zur <sup>CIT:</sup> Germany 1942, director of espionage, Berne, attached to Legation. Formerly attached to I.S. Brussels with Kratzer.
- # REINSTEIN, Dr. Ernst <sup>CIT:</sup> German Attached to Legation, Berne, as head of Gestapo. His office in building of former Czech Legation. ~~Since independence of Czechoslovakia~~  
In charge of economic department at German Legation, Berne.
- # REUTER <sup>free</sup> or ROSTER <sup>CIT: Germany</sup> Germany Said to have been leader of German Intelligence Post at Konstanz which was closed since many of its agents had been arrested.
- # WITTM <sup>free</sup>
- # WOLF, Hans <sup>CIT:</sup> Germany 1940, in charge of German I.S. Bodensee district. Address: Sigmundstrasse, 16, Konstanz. Usually resides at Munich.
