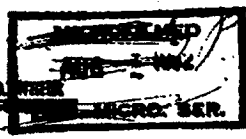

BERNE

LEISSNER, Korvettenkapitan Hans

German. Gutenbergstrasse, 39. Head of I.S. at Berne as Consul General at Legation. Personally directs counter-espionage

MUEHLEN, Hauptmann von und zur

German. Attached to German Legation. Director of espionage, 1942

MILSEMANN, Oberleutnant Ivan von

Military Attache in 1940. 1939. lived at Schloss Allendingen, suspected of being important intelligence center. Was sent to Sebastopol in November, 1941 as intelligence officer. Reported to have returned to Berne. Possibly Related to Sigurd von Ilsoona, Assistant Military Attache at the Hague before invasion.

BSIN *Swiss German*

Official at Legation. Wife has important connections in Germany. Said to have offered his services to French Legation.

LEONHARD, Oberst

Naturalized German (Swiss by birth). March, 1940, said to have been head of German I.S. Switzerland. May be identical with "Doctor" of Bund Tueuer Eidgenossen espionage case

REUTER or RUETER

German. Attached to Legation, in charge of economic department

BEYER, Helmut

German Commercial Attache at Legation. Formerly with Commercial Intelligence Department of Ministry of Economics.

CHAMIER or CHAMIER-GLISZINSKI Fritz von

German Press Attache, German Legation. Brunmadernstrasse, 88

RINCKMANN, Oswald

Chancellor at German Legation

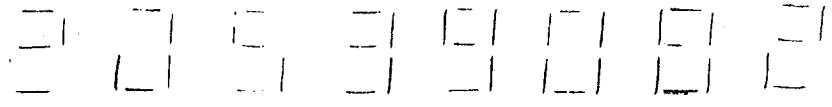
STENZEL, Friedrich

Transferred to German Legation, September, 1943. Former Landesgruppenleiter of Sweden. Engineer. Many commercial contacts in Sweden where he was connected with German S.D.

BERNE

H GARRELS, Hans Georg

Germany. Employed at Legation. Probably identical with individual who was dismissed in 1942 from Zurich branch of Societa de Linoleum, Giubiasco, on account of espionage and 5th column activities.

H NETZEL, Karl

Germany. Member of German Bahazay. June 1943, courier between Switzerland, Barcelona and Madrid, probably economic intelligence.

H FURSTHOFF, Fri. von

Secretary to Meissner, *Handwritten notes*

AGENTS

H CALLEN BERG

Germany (Major) in army. Resided with wife at Hotel Bellevue, Berne.

H CESBROCK, Guillaume

Stated to have worked for Italian Legation, Berne. Also German agent. Was representative of Europa Press Agency. Cripple, moves about in chair.

H CLERUPP

Swiss. On staff of Ultimo A.C. Borsenstrasse.

H EDENBURG, Gerritt (alias van BERSELE)

Dutch. Trained by Germany after invasion and sent to Switzerland, arrested in Berne, 1942.

H EISNER, Oberloutnant Hans

Germany. Sold German passports in Berne. Was employed at Hotel Lutetia, Paris, posing as Jew.

H FREY, Alfred

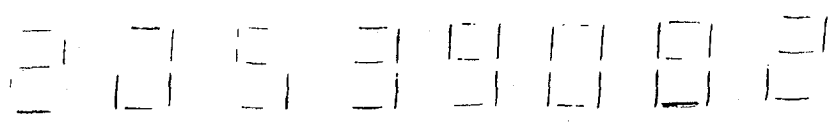
Swiss. Neugasse.

H HARK, Frau von (nee GUTERMAN)

Germany. Counter-espionage.

German 1st Agent, Berne, Switzerland. Cited in Swiss Handbook.

Swiss. German Consulate facilitated his trips to Germany and Paris July 1943.

SCHROEDER, Hans

Germany. Rapsburgstrasse, 19

STELLJES, Berta

Aubausportweg, 2. On British Most Secret Watch List

aka STALTNEDS, Bertha

Aubausportweg, 2. (Same as STELLJES)

STUERLER, von

Swiss. Elfenstrasse, 9. (Lt. Col.) in Swiss Army. Working for German I.S. since 1926

ZELLER

Swiss. Kesslergasse, 26. Photographer. Agent under Groebner, 1942.

FOREIGN DIPLOMATS

HAMED, Abdul

Afghan. Works under protection of Afghan Legation. Transmission agent for German Intelligence. Was head of Afghan Bank, Berlin, 1938

CHAUVIN, Colonel

French. French Military Attache. Connected with German Military Intelligence

YAMANA

Japanese. Japanese Legation, 1942. Espionage against U.K. and U.S.

ANLARI, M. Hassan Ali

Iranian. Assistant Military Attache, Iran Legation. In touch with German I.S. 1943

KIMURA, T.

1942 Japanese Military Attache. (see ARANI)

LYNCH, Senor Norla

Chilean Minister. 1942, reported works for German I.S.

STERGNI, Antonio

Italian. German agent, 1939

BERNE

BOHLE, Hans von

German. Counsellor of Legation. Chief of NSDAP. Principal agent of Von Ribbentrop Bureau, succeeding Freiherr von Bibra

BIBRA, Freiherr Ernst Sigmund von

German. 1939-40 head of Gestapo in Switzerland. 1942, Counselor of Embassy. Waldreitstrasse, 23, Burib, near Berne. May have left for Madrid early in 1943

H. HAAS, for

CIT

German. Attached to von Bibra. Represented association of important provincial newspapers in France before war. Arrested in Paris in 1938, subsequently released. Arrived in Berne April 1939. Said to be organizing anti-French campaign in Switzerland

REIBSTEIN, Dr. Ernst

Deputy of von Bibra. Has office in building of former Czech Legation. Former Geneva correspondent of D.N.B.

KLEINGENFUSS, Karl

German. Hotel Bristol. Attached to Legation. Replaced Dr. Asten. Chief S.S. agent, sent to assist von Bibra

H. BOJLAC, Heinrich

CIT

German Consul at Berne, formerly Davos. 1942 visited Switzerland on behalf of Party headquarters

H. R. ZIG, W.

Professor at Berne University. Member of Academic Council and head of local group of NSDAP

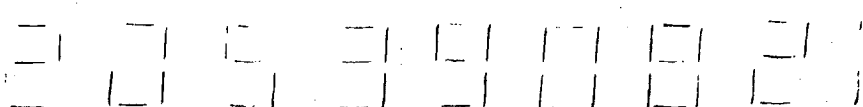
H. DEBOOR, for

Professor at Berne University. Attached to Academic Council of NSDAP

H. FAHRBRUCH, for

Head of Nazi Student Association of Berne. Lives with one Frey, professor at University

Germany Public Prosecutor of Nazi Courts. Was principal agent of Nazi propaganda in France

Professor of Theology at Berne University. Member of Academic Council of NSDAP

STEIGER, Hans

Germany Helped take emigrants over Swiss-German border
