- BAERTSCHINGER, Cestensia ✓
Supposed to have been sentenced for subversive activities in Switzerland
- ✓ BODL, Hans
Supposed to have been sentenced for subversive activities
- # B. KH. (Dr.) Alois Robert
cit. Gachowlska
Czech. Arrested in 1937 and sentenced to 4 months imprisonment and deportation *Alleged German agent*
- ✓ # BONARD, M. *cit. France*
French. Residing in Antibes. Frequently visiting Switzerland to meet German and Italian agents *German to G. Gachowlska, Switzerland*
Lover of Mme. van Kyok
- L. EP'ER
HAAS, Konrad A.
✓ Vaduz, Lichtenstein. *cit.* Bookseller. Said to have helped to get German agents to Switzerland via Lichtenstein. Disappeared. Said to have been kidnapped to Germany *Alleged German agent in Switzerland*
- # HAMIR, Abdul
cit. Afghanistan
Afghan. Assistant to Abdul Ahmed Khan. Said to have worked with above in Afghan Bank, Berlin, 1938
- # MICHAUD, Jean
cit. ?
Frequently met Dr. Hermann (q.v.) at Villa le Crillon, Croppet, Lake of Geneva *Switzerland*
- # VAN ABZADSH, Asgar *cit. Iran*
Persian. Expelled from Turkey for German intelligence work. Fled to Switzerland where he practices law and engages in currency transactions. May be identical with Ali Asghar
- # VELIKOTNY, Vladimir
cit. USSR
White Russian. Former Spanish Press Attache in Ankara. Expected to visit Switzerland soon. At present, Absent agent in Sofia, Bulgaria
- VELTIEN
Dutch? Denounced by Edenburg (q.v.) as spying among Dutch refugees in Nyon
