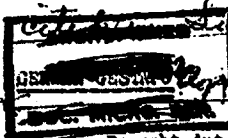

Brought into Switzerland by Sir Oliver Duncan. Claims Argentinian citizenship. Said to be returning to U.S. in December 1945

O.T. Hungary

Hungarian, A 22 Ave. Von Repas, Lausanne. Working under Gestapo Headquarters, Berlin

✓ **BARCHLI, Oskar**

Switzerland
Swiss Customs Inspector

✓ **BECHER (alias RICHTER) Dr. Walter**

Helped to capture Jewish Refugees

✓ **BESTERMAN, Dr. Leopold**

Austrian. Reitergasse, 16, Zurich. Jewish attorney, lived in Paris until 1939, went to Switzerland upon expulsion. Poses as refugee. Was friend of Dr. Steinhausl, prominent Viennese Nazi

Waldreidstrasse, 23, Burib near Berne. 1939 to 1940, head of Gestapo in Switzerland. Nov. 1942, directing intelligence at Consulate, Zurich

Hotel Beau Sejour, Geneva. Liaison between German Consulate, Geneva and Frontier Control and customs at Annecy and Annemasse

✓ **EICH**

Zurzach. Customs official in Jestetten, implicated in effort to entice socialist barrister, Schmutziger, across border into Germany

✓ **GELKE, Karl**

4 Place du Grand Mesel, Geneva. Chief of Gestapo, Geneva, working from German Consulate. President of Deutscher Kriegerverein

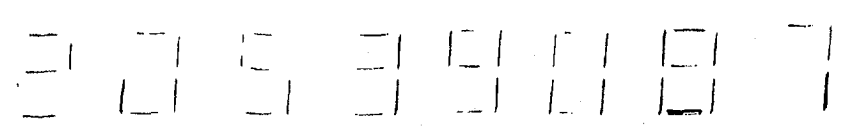

German Vice Consul, Zurich, head of Zurich Gestapo. Schiedhaldenstrasse, 39

H. GRÄBE (or BRITZ) Countess Rachel

Former American. Said to be very pro-German. When living in Berlin, associated a lot with American Diplomats in order to get information. Has friends in pay of Gestapo

President of Commune of Zurzach. Lieutenant in Swiss army. Tried to lure escaped Gestapo prisoner back to Germany. Sentenced to 3 months imprisonment

KLINDENFUSS, Karl

Hotel Bristol, Berne, attached to German Legation. Replaced Dr. Astan, Chief S.S. agent sent to assist von Bibra

MARSTZ, Friedrich

Swiss customs official

MANZ, Hans

Helped kidnap German Refugees

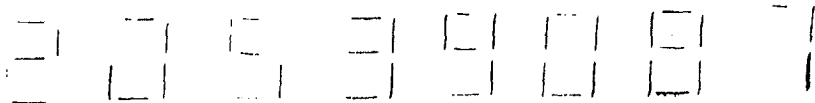

Germany
Working under orders from Stuttgart. Tried to entice refugees back to Germany

SCHULZ

Basel. Mentioned in Berthold Jacobs affair

STIRZEL (or STIRZEL)

Reported one of Foedtli's agents. Took Gestapo courses in Nuremberg and Munich

THOEDTLI, Boris. (alias TAUBER, alias HAECKELING)
Cit. SSR

Cover Address: *Switzerland*
Mayerl Cigares, Seefeldstrasse, 58, Zurich. Passed information to Colonel Fleischauer's "Maldienat" agency at Erfurt.

TREFF, Hans

Took course in Mannheim

TREUBER

St. Julien. Worked on Franco-Swiss border

WEIGANG, Wilhelm

Stayed at Geneva Hotel in 1936. Reported to pose as emigre. Knows frontier districts well

WESEMANN, Hans

Implicated in Berthold Jacobs affair. Said now to be in prison

ROTHE

Stated to be German agent at Loerrach. Helps German agents cross German-Swiss frontier
