AGENTS Germany IN SWITZERLAND

Noted in Swiss handbook

HANSTETZ, Hans *CIT: P*

Allegedly Espionage in Zurich. *Said to have fled to Vienna.*

H. ASSEN or Dr. ASITON *CIT: Germany*

Was connected with passport section at German Consulate, Zurich. Recalled to Germany at request of Swiss because of running espionage organization.

H. BAUM, Ernest

CIT: Germany Expelled in 1939 for espionage. Old address: 2 Rue Miller-Arn, Geneva.

H. BEBE, Albert *CIT: Switzerland*

Swiss. Formerly at Neftaubach, near Zurich. 1943, sentenced by default to life imprisonment for military and economic espionage.

H. BODMER, K. *CIT: Switzerland*

Swiss. Sentenced to 6 months imprisonment by default for espionage.

H. BOHRMANN, Josef

CIT: Germany In charge of German I.S. under cover of consular position. Deported in 1943. Old address: Feilerendstrasse 15, Basel.

H. BOESCH, Bernhard

CIT: Germany Davos. Expelled in 1943 for organizing political intelligence service.

H. BOHME, Georg

CIT: Germany German Vice-Consul, Davos. Recalled when secret German radio transmitter was discovered at Sanatorium of Dr. Burkhardhaus (see Strasser).

H. BONZO, Valfre di *CIT: Italy*

Former Vice Consul (Italian) at Geneva. Later transferred as Military Attache to Moscow. Lt. Colonel, supposed to have been link between Italian Consulate and Kochat.

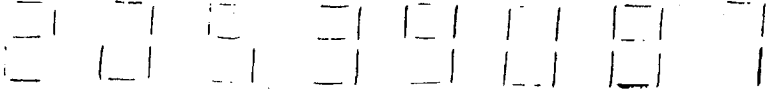
H. BUELER, (Dr.) *CIT: Switzerland*

Swiss. *Lawyer*. Sentenced by default.

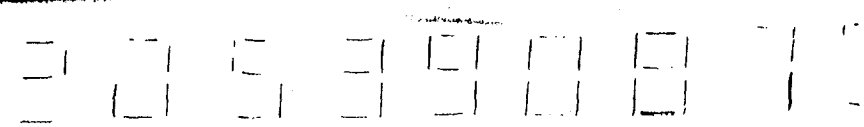

AGENTS FORMERLY IN SWITZERLAND

- H BRUCHNER, Charles *CIT: Switzerland*
 Swiss. He and wife doing naval intelligence in Zurich. Arrested in Tangier, then returned to Germany.
- H MORI, Franz *CIT: Switzerland*
 Swiss. Sentenced by default to 5 years. Leader of Lucerne department of Eidgenossische Korrespondenz of NSDAP. Probably in Germany now.
- H GREN, Erich *CIT: Germany*
 Employed in German Consulate, Basel. Arrested for recruiting I.A.S. agents. Returned to Germany.
- H COB, Vincent (alias Victor HARDY) *CIT: Albanian*
 Albanian. Old address: 14 Rue Jean Jaquet, Geneva. Arrested by French at Ammanas and condemned to death. German or Italian agent, now supposed to be working in Brussels as Victor Hardy.
- H DAIN, Hugo *CIT: Switzerland*
 Swiss. Sentenced by default to 10 years imprisonment.
- H DERMIDOFF, (Major) Umberto *CIT: Italy*
 Former Assistant Commercial Attache, Bern, in charge of Italian counter-espionage, Switzerland. Replaced by Bianchi. Said to have returned to Rome.
- H DODNER, Manela *CIT: Germany*
 Neue Ansbacherstrasse, 18, Berlin. Agent working in Geneva and Germany.
- H DURST, Rene *CIT: France*
 French. Old address: 2 Rue Grenus, Geneva. ~~Employed~~ agents to spy in France for Italy. Wife, Henriette nee Juvet. Arrested by French police. Ran Cafe "Au Rond Point" at Moillesulles, few yards from frontier. Removed to Lyons in 1939.
- H ENGEL, Fritz Karl *CIT: Germany*
 Cassarate, near Lugano. Expelled for life in 1938 for denouncing members of German colony.

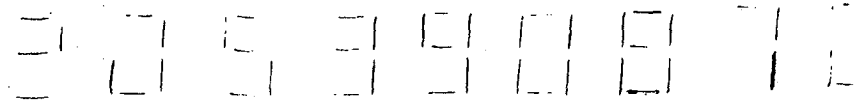

U.S. AGENTS FORMERLY IN SWITZERLAND

- # FEBER, Siegfried *CIT* Germany Sentenced b. default to 20 years for military and political espionage
- # FORNI, Germaine *CIT* French. 12 Rue Granus, Geneva. *Switzerland*
Escaped to Italy, having recruited agents for Italian I.S. (see Grotler)
- # FRANCAVILLA, Dorothy Kate *SCR: F* Imperial di, *Switzerland*
(nee Ransden) *CIT: K* British. Hotel de la Residence, Geneva. Supposed to have gone to Italy in 1939. Travelled a lot to France, interested in information on French Army units. (see Codati)
- # FREI, Johann *CIT* Swiss. *Switzerland*
Swiss Military intelligence. *Swiss*
Sentenced by default to 2 years in 1939. Probably left Switzerland
- # FUCHS, Agnes (nee Keer) *CIT* Swiss. Sentenced to 8 years by default
- # FURBER (alias BERINGER) *CIT* Germany. Leader of intelligence post at Konstanz. Recalled to Stuttgart
- # GAERTNER, Heinrich Friedrich Wilhelm *CIT* Germany. Les Colombelles, Geneva. *Switzerland*
Expelled in 1939. Believed now to be in Moscow
- # NORM, Alfred *CIT* Germany Sentenced to death by default for military espionage
- # HEIMALT, Heinz Koefler von *CIT* Germany. 24 Kueschelerstrasse, Zurich. Expelled, 1943 as suspected agent of German I.S. *Switzerland*
German Legation at Berne tried to intervene for him. Doctor of Chemistry. Frequently travelled to Germany and Czechoslovakia
- # HEUDORFER, Franz Josef *CIT* Swiss. German agent who left for France
- # GHIGNANI, Giovanni *CIT* Italian business man. Sentenced to 1 year in prison for economic espionage and 10 years banishment

AGENTS FORMERLY IN SWITZERLAND

HILSEMANN, Oberleutnant Ivan von *CIT* Germany Military Attache, Berns, 1939, lived at Schloss Allmendingen, near Berns. Intelligence officer. Possibly related to Sigurd von Ilseman, Assistant Military Attache, The Hague, before invasion. May have returned to Germany

HUBER, Mrs. J. *SEX: F* Swiss. 42 Rue Grenus, Geneva. *Switzerland* Mother-in-law of Rene Duret, arrested with him for working for Italian I.S. Removed to Lyons in 1939

KARUPFER, Wilhelm *CIT* German Sentenced to 2 months imprisonment and 10 years expulsion

KELLER, Dr. Max Leo *CIT Switzerland* Swiss. Sentenced by default to 6 years imprisonment, military espionage. Prominent Frontist

KNOLL or KNOLL, Frits Karl *CIT Germany* Convicted, expelled for life

LEBER, Olga *CIT Italy - SEX: F* Italian. *Italy* Working for Italian I.S. Expelled in 1939

LEU ✓ Swiss. Sentenced by default to 6 years for military espionage

LIENHARTSTEIN, (Prince) Ferdinand *CIT* Liechtensteiner. 432 Oberin du Village, Chailly, near Lausanne. *Switzerland* Ardent Catholic, reported as German agent, Lausanne, 1932. Worked for German I.S. Vienna. Went to Finland in 1940 with Princess of Hessa. Travelled to Germany frequently. Believed to have returned

MANZI, (Count) Stefan *CIT Italy* Italian Vice Consul, Geneva. Said to have been in touch with *allegedly* Boghat, later transferred to Paris as 4th Secretary at Italian Embassy

MARONIA-REKOWITZ, (Grav) Rudolf von *CIT* Germany In charge of I.S. Munich, 1938. Important officer for South-Eastern Europe. Arrested by Swiss in 1937, sentenced to 3 months for espionage against France. Now stationed in Vienna

HATHIER, Rene

French, Jewish origin. Courier for German Legation, Bern. Now working for Gestapo, Paris

IATTE

Italian. Agent, 1939. Expelled

LEBER, Jacob

Germany Sentenced by default. Living in Stuttgart, 1942

MESSERSCHMIDT, (Dr.) Eberhard

Germany Agricultural Attaché at German Legation Bern. Has post box at 5 Rue du Vieux Co. Geneva. 1942, transferred to Anglo-American Section of German Embassy, Rome

MICHELINI, *Italy*

Italian. Commercial Attaché at Italian Consulate, Basel, associated with Gestapo. Tried to establish Italian intelligence post. Recalled to Rome, 1942

ROSSER, Hans *Switzerland*

Swiss. Fribourg. Agent 1939. Said to have gone to London and Paris in 1940. May be identical with SIGEL and SPANWILE

✓ NAPOLSKI *pages 35-37*

German. Director of Chamber of Commerce, Zurich. In charge of German economic espionage. Said to have been arrested in 1942

NIKLES, Alfred *see pages 77, 84, 105*

Swiss. Set up secret radio station at Interlaken. 1939, sentenced to 6 months imprisonment, later 2 years by default for military espionage

NICOLAI, Colonel

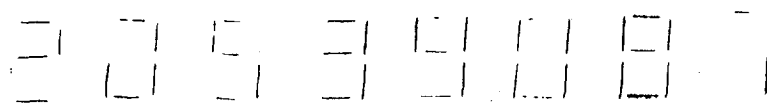
Germany Head of German Secret Service during last war. 1938, reported to have been in Switzerland on special mission

NOERDOERFER, (Dr.) Walter

Germany Owner of Schloss Rheinburg, Gallingen. Member of Bund Treuer Eidgenossen. Expelled

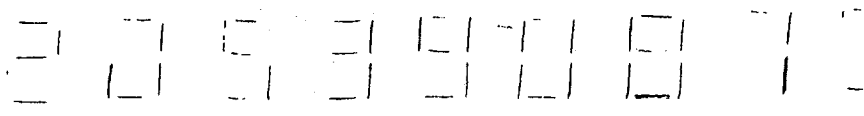

AGENTS EARLIER IN SWITZERLAND

- Swiss*
 H OSWALD, Emil *Swiss*
 Swiss. 1942, sentenced by default to 10 years. Fled to Stuttgart from Zurich
- HOTTZENN, Paula *CIT*
 Swiss. Actress in Berne. Expelled in 1942
- H REHN, K.F. *CIT*
 Swiss. Sentenced by default to 2 months imprisonment
- H SCHLATTER, Rudolf *CIT*
 Swiss. Quartermaster in Swiss Army. Sentenced by default to 18 months imprisonment for military espionage
- H SCHREIBER, Hans *CIT*
 Swiss. Superintendent of Federal Arsenal, Langnau. Sentenced by default to 15 years. Fled from Switzerland
- H SCHELZE, *CIT*
 Germany. Rue Marignac, Geneva. Engaged in military espionage with Gaertner. Expelled, 1939
- H STELLA, Capitano Vincente *CIT Italy*
 Italian. Vice Consul, Geneva, 1939. Later lived at Maison J. Gras, Collonges s/Salève, France
- H STREIBEL, Hans *CIT*
 Germany. Head of German Central Foreign Tourist Bureau of Railways, probably Geneva, where, in 1940, he set up German propaganda bureau. 1943, arrested in Basel with von Koenitz, Director of Luftwaffe. Said to have been courier for German Legation, Berne, which demanded his release
- THOMAS, Werner
 German. Pension Elisa, 19 Rue Chantepoulet, Geneva. Berlin Police officer. Believed to have returned to Germany
- H ULRICH, Huber *CIT*
 German. 1942, sentenced to 18 months imprisonment and expulsion

H. H. G., Oberleutnant

CIT. Germany 1939-42, I.S. officer at German Legation, Bern, 1942, transferred to Paris to direct operational intelligence. Set up network of military intelligence agents to penetrate British and French possessions in West Africa

H. WASSERMANN, H.S. fr.
21. 6. 41. Austria

Switzerland
Viennese. Hotel Elite, Place Longsalle, Geneva. Also *Geneva* Lathieu, 20 Quai Gustav Ador. Paris address: 26 Rue Eugene Delacroix. Arrested by Swiss in 1939, but nothing was found. Was to be returned to Germany, but insisted on being sent to Italy

H. WEGELIN, H. *CIT. Switzerland*

CCC
Swiss. Sentenced by default to 3 years. Former editor of "Berner Tagblatt" and prominent member of Nationale Front

H. WILDI, Eugen
CIT. Switzerland

Swiss. 1936, he and wife arrested for running espionage organization. Acted as intermediary between one Dr. Ernst of Berlin and "Neue Basler Zeitung". Had agent in Basel. Probably left Switzerland in 1942 for Belgium. Partisan of Alsatian autonomist movement

H. WILLY, Frank
CIT. Switzerland

Swiss. Sentenced by default in 1943 to 6 months. Former member of Nationale Front

H. ZOGHEB, Isabella. (Countess) (nee Scelsi) *CIT. Denmark?*

Danish Passport. Expelled, 1939. Left for Milan. Wife of Count Patrice de Zogheb, suspected of espionage for Italy at Copenhagen, 1937

WJRZ

Said to be chief of political police, Loerrach. Arrested for having made unauthorized investigations and expelled from Switzerland
