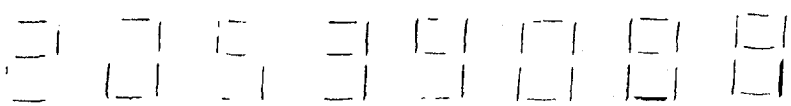

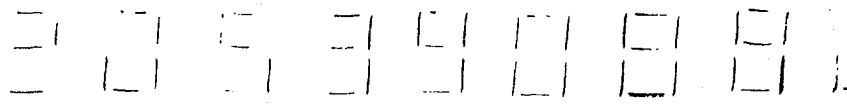

HSDNER, Willi <i>see page 38</i>	Swiss. Working in Gaiasso under German Consulate, Zurich
HERZIG, Gustav etc <i>see page 12</i>	Swiss. Hairdresser, Lucerne. Sentenced to 3 years imprisonment
HUBER, Ernst <i>see page 41</i>	Swiss. Sentenced in 1942 to 4 months imprisonment

German. Member of Nationale Front. Major in Swiss Army. 1942, sentenced to 18 months imprisonment. Possibly identical with Walter Muehlebach, Nazi agent

MUELLER, Hermann

German. Working under AST, Stuttgart

Swiss. Head of Schutzkorps of Bund Treuer Eidgenossen. Set up secret radio station, Interlaken. 1939, sentenced to 6 months imprisonment, later 2 years by default. May be identical with Regierungsdirektor Nifles, head of Arbeitsamt, Mannheim

NUESSLI, Frida Henriette (nee *Schwarz*)

Swiss. *Zurich*. Domestic servant. Sentenced at Berne in 1942 to 18 months imprisonment

German. Travelled to Switzerland in September, 1942 as German agent

Swiss. Recruited by Engelbrechten to go to North Africa on military espionage for Germany. Arrested in North Africa in October, 1943

Swiss. 34 Avenue de la Gare, Delle. Mechanic who was planted as agent by German I.S. in Usines Dielectriques, above address. Works under I.S. at Basel

Swiss. 1939 sentenced to 4 months imprisonment. Murich correspondent of Bodensee Rundschau and N.S. Kurier of Stuttgart. Propaganda Chief of Nationale Front. Later joined Bund Treuer Eidgenossen

SCHERS, Ernst
47

German. Maybe identical with Major Schers, member of counter-espionage of German I.S.

H. STREIB, Gefreiter Adolf (alias C. F. Germany)
Hans Moser, alias (Unteroffizier)
Alfred SPACHLE *Cpt.*

Germany 1942, undertook to work for Swiss I.S. against Germany as Hans Moser. September, 1942 went to Germany as Alfred Spachle. was sent to Stuttgart, admitted to German authorities that he had been sent as a spy, was taken on as a German agent and sent back to Switzerland in the same month.

SONDEREGGER, Louis Joseph

Business man at Oberegg. Sentence to 18 months imprisonment for sabotage of military materials

STAUFFER, Oberleutenant

Swiss. Reserve Officer in Swiss Army. German I.S. interested in him in 1941. Very anti-British

Swiss. Hafenstrasse, 9, Berne. Lt. Col. in Swiss Army. Working for German I.S. since 1926

Swiss. Corporal in Swiss Army. Sentenced Feb. 1942 to 2 years imprisonment for military espionage

Switzerland

Swiss. July, 1945, German I.S. believed to be wanting to use him as courier and military agent. Travelled to Balkans

TSCHUMI, Jakob

Swiss. Berne. Sergeant in Swiss Army. March 1943 sentenced to 2 years imprisonment

German. 1939-42, I.S. officer at German Legation, Berne. 1942, transferred to Paris to direct operational intelligence. Set up network of military intelligence agents to penetrate British and French possessions in West Africa

WACHTEL

WACHTEL - 7

German. Part owner of Rex and Capitol cinemas, Basel. 1942, German agent, military intelligence. Used German cabaret dancers as sub-agents. On good terms with Zurich police

WESER, Max

German. Sent military intelligence to Stuttgart

WIPPLI

Swiss. Sentenced with Labof in 1942 to 15 years imprisonment for Military espionage

H WIPFEL, Alois

in Switzerland

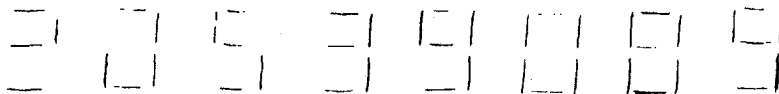
Swiss. Panoramaplein, Stuttgart, Germany; 1942, German I.S. made arrangements for him to go to Switzerland from Stuttgart. Engaged in Military intelligence

SINDT, Otto	Bahnhofstrasse, 74, Zurich. Post box for H.K.F. Bahr, who was ar- rested on "Drottingholm" by FBI as German spy

Swiss. Wife of J.R.A. Pagan. 10 Rue des Cedres, Geneva. Acted as post box between her husband and von Engelbrechten

*FRASCOLLI, Ernest Luethi

Swiss. 51 Rue Haller, Berne, or 9 Aarhaldenstrasse, Berne. Post-box for reports from German I.S. agents in South America. On British Most Secret Watch List

Swiss. Wireless station at Interlaken. Agent of Bund Treuer Kidnappers. Reported on activities of French legation, Berne

FRIGERIO, Annibal
Italy

Italian. *Switzerland* As Chemin Byron, Coligny, Geneva. Has wireless set. Commercial German espionage

HAAS, Otto

CIT Germany. Owner of Schloss Gutenberg, Balzers, Lichtenstein, where German I.S. had wireless sending station

NIKLES, Alfred
Switzerland

Swiss. Set up secret radio station at Interlaken. 1939, sentenced to 6 months, later two years by default for military espionage. May be identical with Registrar Direktor NIKLES, head of Arbeitsamt, Mannheim

SCHAFFNER, Agnes
SEX: F

Switzerland
CIT Germany. 19/4 Innere Margarethenstrasse, Basel. Was in radio contact with agents in Libya, 1942. Above address used by Italian Vice Consul Lichelini, Geneva. Also post box for German agents in Syria

STRASSER, *Germany*
CIT

Head Waiter at Sanatorium of Dr. Burckhardt, Davos. Arrested when German radio transmitting station was found at above address, but subsequently released. Still under supervision
