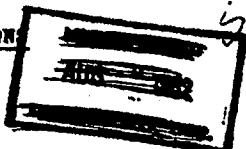

INTRODUCTION

The BUND TREUER EINGENOSSEN is a Swiss Fascist organization, founded in 1936, after the German-Austrian Anschluss, by Dr. Alfred Zander. During the trial of the latter, at which he was sentenced to one and a half years hard labor, he claimed that it was not the aim of the BUND to annex Switzerland to Germany, but this statement was disproved by the production of various letters.

The NATIONALE FRONT is a Swiss political party which adopted National-Socialism in 1931. Its leader was Dr. Rudolf Hanne. Its aims in general were similar to those of the Rexist party in Belgium. Since in recent years many of its prominent members had been arrested, it was reported that the party was on the point of disintegration.

It is reported that the SWISS S.A. is a small organization, organized on the pattern of the Austrian Legion at Munich. It was organized and founded by one Dr. Morganti who received funds from Germany for the purpose.

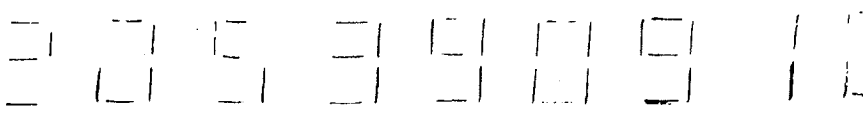
The VOELSBUND FUER DAS DEUTSCHUM IM AUSLAND (V.D.A.) was originally founded in order to maintain cultural ties with those in foreign countries of German extraction. Since the accession to power of the Nazis, it has been used as a propaganda organization, and to propagate "Germanism" abroad under the active leadership and control of the National-Socialist Party.

BUND TREUER EIDGENOSSEN

ZANDER, Dr. Alfred

Founder. Editor of "Eiserer Bosen". 1938 provided F.S. Kurier, Stuttgart with reports on Swiss newspapers. 1939, sentenced to 18 months imprisonment

NIKLES, Alfred

Secretary. Set up secret radio station at Interluken. 1939 sentenced to 6 months imprisonment, later 2 years by default for military espionage. May be identical with Regierungsdirktor Nikles, head of Arbeitsamt Mannheim

H BONNY, Paul

Swiss. Rue Balle Jung, Geneva

DRPE'DENGLER, Otto

Swiss. Geneva, Agent of Bund

DISSLIK, Werner

Swiss. Berne. Agent of Bund. Wireless station at Interluken

FRII, Johann

Swiss. In charge of intelligence section of Bund. Provided military intelligence. Sentenced to 2 years imprisonment by default, 1939

LEONHARD, Oberst

Naturalized German. Swiss by birth. March 1940, Head of German I.S. in Switzerland. May be identical with "Doctor" of Bund Treuer Eidgenossen espionage case

H SITZ, Hans

Swiss. Manager of Palace Cinema, Zurich. Agent of Bund. 1939, sentenced to 2 months imprisonment for espionage

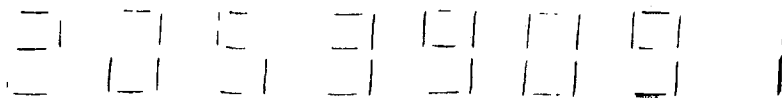
ZANDER, Conrad

Swiss. Agent of Bund. Brother of Alfred Zander. 1939, sentenced to 1 month imprisonment. Used secret ink. Probably identical with "G.E." assistant to Schaefer, head of Nazi Party Ortsgruppe Palermo, 1940

BAUR, Fritz

Swiss. Erlenbach 106, Seestrasse. Zurich. Closely associated with Front. 1941, in charge of Hotel Baur au Lac

EISENHUT, Dr. Hermann

Prominent Leader of Front. Editor of "Die Front" and "Der Grenzboten". Sentenced for subversive activities

GNRTIS, Paul

Swiss. 16 Promenade St. Antoine. Former member of Front. Recruiter for German I.S.

LEINHARDT, Major Ernst

Swiss. Member of Front. 1942, sentenced to 5 years hard labor for subversive activities

LINDT

Swiss. Prominent member of Front. Berne. 1942, sentenced to 2 years imprisonment for military espionage

MAYER, Josef

Swiss. Member of Front. 1943 sentenced to 3 years imprisonment for military espionage

MUEHLEMAN

German. Member of Front. Major in Swiss Army. 1942, sentenced to 18 months imprisonment for military espionage. Possibly identical with Walter Muehleemann, Nazi agent

LEONHARDT, Major Ernst Swiss. Member of group. Also member of Nationale Front. Ex-Major in Swiss Army, 1942, attempted to organize Swiss legion for Russian front. Probably fled to Germany. *Detained 5 yrs in Swiss prison*
