

Supreme Court has ordered the release of Klaus Altman, wanted for justice for war crimes in France, who he was Gestapo chief in Lyons under the name of Klaus Barbie during World War II.

The Supreme Court reversed a ruling it issued in March upholding the decision to keep Altman in preventive custody and ordered him freed on his own recognizance pending a decision on France's request for extradition.
