1. This office is responding to a request from the Department of Justice for Army intelligence investigative records concerning Klaus Barbie.
2. In reviewing the Army intelligence investigative records within the request, the attached records (enclosure 1), originating with your organization were identified. These records are forwarded for your declassification determination and direct reply to this office.
3. The Office of Special Investigations, Criminal Division, Department of Justice is concluding its investigation into Klaus Barbie's relationship with various U.S. Agencies. This review is requested to determine what information, if any, can be declassified for release to the public and the media in a general statement.
