- 3. THE COLLAPSE OF THE INTERNATIONAL CAPITALIST FINANCIAL SYSTEM IN GENERAL AND THE DIFFICULTIES WITH THE U.S. ECONOMY IN PARTICULAR WERE ALSO HIGHLIGHTED THROUGHOUT THE WEEK. SPECIAL DAILY ATTENTION WAS DEVOTED TO THE TRUCKERS STRIKE IN THE U.S. AND THE VIOLENCE THAT AC-COMPANIED IT.
