COUNTRY MINISTERS IS HEADLINED. REPORTS QUOTE PRESIDENT REAGAN'S REMARK TUESDAY THAT OIL PRICE CUT IS "GOOD NEWS FOR WORLD ECONOMY". REGAN'S AND SHULTZ'S DECLARATIONS ON SAME ISSUE ARE ALSO NOTED. THERE ARE PLENTY OF ANECTOTES ILLUSTRATING THE CHANGE.... NO ONE OTHER THAN SOVIET OFFICIALS ARE PREPARED TO SAY THAT ANDROPOV'S REFORMS WILL WORK. BUT ANDROPOV APPEARS DETERMINED....

WHILE WE CANNOT YET SPEAK OF A TRUE 'PURGE'-- MOST OF THE MEN PUT ON THE SIDELINES WERE VERY OLD--ANDROPOV'S PURPOSE IS TO CREATE A FEELING OF ANXIETY AMONG MEMBERS OF THE ADMINISTRATION AND PARTY OFFICIALS. THERE IS WORRY ALSO ABOUT THIS ARTICLE IN 'SOVIET RUSSIA' DATED JANUARY 19 ANNOUNCING THE CREATION OF REEDUCATION CENTERS FOR PEOPLE HAVING AN 'ANTISOCIAL AND PARASITIC WAY OF LIFE' ...
