FRENCH PRESS TODAY IS DOMINATED BY RESULTS OF YESTERDAY'S SECOND ROUND MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS, WHICH SEE SOCIALIST PARTY RECOUP FIRST ROUND LOSSES WITH ELECTION OF NINE MINISTERS TO MUNICIPAL POSTS.

CONCLUSION OF THE NON-ALIGNED SUMMIT GETS WIDE PLAY, WITH SOCIALIST AND COMMUMIST PAPERS PLAYING UP THE EXPRESSED ANTI-AMERICANISM AND ANTI-IMPERIALISM.

ON EUROMISSILE ISSUE, REAGAN IS SEEN AS BEING PRESSURED BY A CONGRESS LEANING TO SUPPORT FOR THOSE EUROPEAN COUNTRIES CALLING FOR A GESTURE OF GOODWILL IN GENEVA.
