SUMMARY:

CHAD IS THE ONLY INTERNATIONAL ISSUE ON THE FRONT PAGES OF THE FRENCH PRESS TODAY. COVERAGE IS GIVEN TO HABRE'S PRESS CONFERENCE, THE CONCLAVE IN BRAZZAVILLE AND THE ATTEMPTS TO ENCOURAGE NEGOCIATIONS. LE MONDE CARRIES A LONG STORY BY ELYSEE CORRESPONDENT ERIC ROULEAU ON MITTERRAND'S STRATEGY IN CHAD AND HIS DIFFERENCES AND PROBLEMS WITH THE US ADMINISTRATION. ALTHOUGH NOT IDENTIFIED AS SUCH, IT IS KNOWN TO BE AN INTERVIEW WITH THE FRENCH PRESIDENT. STORY WAS MENTIONED ON EVENING TELEVISION NEWS PROGRAMS AND ALSO PICKED UP BY LIBERATION. (FULL FRENCH TEXT IS BEING REPORTED SEPTEL BY EMBASSY POLITICAL SECTION). LE MATIN CARRIES A FRONT PAGE REPORT ON THE 'UNOFFICIAL' VISIT TO LIBYA OF ROLAND DUMAS, A FRIEND OF MITTERAND. POLAND AND CHILE CONTINUE TO RECEIVE INSIDE PAGE COVERAGE DRAWN FROM WIRE SERVICE DISPATCHES. THE US JUSTICE DEPARTMENT'S REPORT ON KLAUS BARBIE WAS WIDELY COVERED, WITHOUT MUCH COMMENTARY, ON LAST NIGHT'S TELEVISION AND RADIO NEWS. REPORT WAS QUOTED, ESPECIALLY APOLOGY TO FRENCH GOVERNMENT. TREATMENT WAS MUTED IN WRITTEN PRESS. (EMBASSY POLITICAL SECTION REPORTING FULL PRESS COVERAGE BY SEPTEL). THE US HAD NOT WEIGHED IN HEAVILY, BOTH BEFORE AND
AFTER THE ACTUAL CRISIS. FRANCE IS NOT IGNORANT OF THE
FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE (...) THAT THE US FURNISHED TO
HABRE IN SUDAN TO CONQUER N'DJAMENA. IN PARIS THE

FIRST THE AMERICAN PRESS AND THEN PRESIDENT REAGAN

EVOKED THE 'COOPERATION' BETWEEN WASHINGTON AND PARIS. (...) OTHERS, NOTABLY SOVIET COMMENTATORS, TOOK THE OPPORTUNITY TO ACCUSE THE FRENCH OF BEING 'SUPPLETIVES' OF 'AMERICAN IMPERIALISM'. (...) WHAT IS MORE NATURAL THAN SUCH CONTACTS? THE COMMON AIM OF THE TWO CAPITOLS IS TO OBTAIN THE WITHDRAWAL OF THE LIBYIAN FORCES. HOWEVER, ABOVE AND BEYOND THIS OBJECTIVE, THE TWO COUNTRIES DIVERGE ON ALMOST ALL ASPECTS: THE MEANS TO THE END, THEIR ANALYSES AND THEIR MOTIVATIONS. MR. MITTERRAND'S STRATEGY (...) DOES NOT INCLUDE OVERTHROWING KADDAFI, FOR WHOM HE NOURISHES NO HOSTILITY OR HATE.
