SUBJECT: DAILY MEDIA REACTION REPORT MONDAY NOVEMBER 14, 1983 - SUMMARY MAJOR STORIES IN THE FRENCH PRESS TODAY: PRESIDENT REAGAN'S VISIT TO SOUTH KOREA, EDITORIAL TOPIC IN LES ECHOS AND HUMANITE, RECEIVES SIGNIFICANT INSIDE-PAGE COVERAGE IN OTHER PARIS PAPERS WITH PHOTO OF PRESIDENT USING BINOCULARS OR WATCHING OTHER SIDE DURING DMZ TOUR. HIS REMARK THAT U.S. TROOPS ARE STATIONED ON THE "FRONT LINE OF FREEDOM" IS HEADLINED IN ALL PAPERS. QUOTES ARE LARGELY FROM REMARKS DURING DMZ VISIT INCLUDING THOSE ON GRENADA AND MIDDLE EAST. BOTH TV NETWORKS CARRIED BRIEF REPORTS ON BOTH AFTERNOON AND EVENING NEWS PROGRAMS SHOWING THE PRESIDENT "ON FRONT LINE." FRANCE-INTER RADIO SAID: "THE U.S. PRESIDENT HAS BEEN DOING HIS THING AGAIN. HE VISITED THE DMZ." MOST PAPERS EMPHASIZE THAT VISIT TO SOUTH KOREA WAS CLOUDED BY CONTINUING REPRESSION OF DOMESTIC OPPOSITION. FIGARO POINTS OUT MEMBERS OF OPPOSITION WERE PRESENT AT RECEPTION FOR PRESIDENT BUT RIGHT-OF-CENTER QUOTIDIEN SAYS "LITTLE TIME WAS DEVOTED TO POLITICAL LIBERALIZATION." MAIN STORY ON LEBANON IS ANNOUNCEMENT THAT PRESIDENT ASSAD HAS FALLEN ILL AND CANNOT RECEIVE GEMAYEL. ALL PAPERS CONTINUE TO SPECULATE ON ARAFAT'S FATE.
