SUBJECT: MEDIA REACTION REPORT, SEPTEMBER 27, 1991

KEY STORIES:

FRONT PAGES WERE DOMINATED BY THE IRAQI NUCLEAR INSPECTIONS.

YUGOSLAVIA:

PRESS REPORTED THE PROGRESS OF THE CEASEFIRE AND LORD CARRINGTON'S PEACE EFFORTS. THE TIMES REPORTED FROM THE HAGUE AND ZAGREB: "LORD CARRINGTON, THE CHAIRMAN OF THE YUGOSLAV PEACE CONFERENCE, YESTERDAY SAID THAT THE COUNTRY'S WARRING REPUBLICS COULD BE REMODELLED INTO A YUGOSLAV ECONOMIC UNION, ALONG THE LINES OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITY. RECOGNIZING THAT THE FRAGILE CEASEFIRE WAS THE MOST HOPEFUL SING OF AN END TO THE CONFLICT, LORD CARRINGTON SAID THE CONFERENCE MUST NOW 'BE ACCELERATED, IN SO FAR AS IT IS POSSIBLE'. CAUTIOUS OPTIMISM ABOUT THE SHAKY CEASEFIRE INCREASED YESTERDAY WHEN FEDERAL ARMY TROOPS AND ARMOR WITHDREW FROM BARRACKS IN THE CROATIAN TOWN OF VINKOVCI, ONE OF THE TENSEST AREAS..." THE GUARDIAN'S CORRESPONDENT SAID "EUROPEAN LEADERS ALLOWED THEMSELVES A MODICUM OF OPTIMISM..." THE INDEPENDENT'S TONY BARBER SAID: "THE TIDE OF WAR TURNS, BUT NO END IS IN SIGHT..."

EUROPE:

IN "UNITY IN A BLOODSTAINED CONTINENT", THE INDEPENDENT'S EDITORIAL COMMENTED: "...THE FACT THAT BRITAIN, ALMOST ALONE IN EUROPE, DID NOT EXPERIENCE NAZI INVASION AND OCCUPATION HELPS TO EXPLAIN THE GREAT DIFFERENCE IN THE INTENSITY WITH WHICH BRITAIN AND OTHER EUROPEANS THINK OF THE ENTERPRISE OF BUILDING A NEW EUROPE. THE ESSENTIAL IDEA OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITY WAS NOT TO PROMOTE TRADE OF HARMONIZE TARIFFS, NOR EVEN TO SUBSIDIZE FARMERS. IT WAS TO END WHAT NOW LOOKED LIKE EUROPEAN CIVLI WAR, AND ENSURE THAT EUROPE SHOULD NEVER AGAIN HAVE TO FEAR MEN LIKE KLAUS BARBIE AND HIS MASTERS.

"PRECISELY BECAUSE BRITAIN DID NOT LIVE UNDER THE SHADOW OF THE SWASTIKA, BRITAIN HAS AN INSTINCT FOR THE WORKINGS OF DEMOCRACY THAT HAS A VITAL CONTRIBUTION TO MAKE TO THE EUROPEAN FUTURE; PRECISELY BECAUSE OUR FELLOW EUROPEANS DID LIVE UNDER THE HARROW OF OCCUPATION THEY MAY HAVE A FIRMER GRIP ON THE FIRST PRINCIPLE OF EUROPEAN POLITICS - THE NEED FOR PEACE AND UNITY IN OUR ANCIENTLY DIVIDED AND BLOODSTAINED CONTINENT."

HOSTAGES:

AS FREED HOSTAGE JACKIE MANN TOLD OF HIS TREATMENT AND TORTURE DURING HIS 865 DAY'S CAPITIVITY IN THE LEBANON, THE TIMES' EDITORIAL, "A FUNNY THING HAPPENING", COMMENTED: "...WHEN THE RAF VC10 FLYNG HIM BACK HAD A HITCH IN ITS LANDING GEAR, MR. MANN OFFERED HIS SERVICES (AS A FORMER PILOT) TO THE FLIGHTDECK. THE CLEAREST SIGNAL TO HIS COUNTRYMEN THAT HIS SPIRIT HAD SURVIVED; THAT AND HIS PRETENCE OF A DATE WITH AN AIR-STEWARDESS...

"AMERICANS LET EVERYTHING HANG OUT, CONTINENTALS MAY KISS, WEEP AND HUG, BUT EVERYTHING THE BRITISH WANT TO SAY ON THE TARMAC OF LIBERATION IS SAID IN THE UNDERSTATEMENT OF A HANDSHAKE AND A JOKE. A FUNNY SORT OF STRENGTH IT SIGNIFIES: AND A GREAT ONE."

THE INDEPENDENT CARRIED AN ARTICLE BY MIDDLE EAST CORRESPONDENT ROBERT FISK. IN "TORTURED BY THE BRUTALIZED", HE SAID THAT ARAB PRISONERS HAVE BEEN TORTURED AAND THAT "...IN THIS CONTEXT, THE PRISONERS OF LEBANON - WHATEVER THEIR NATIONALITY - ARE AS MUCH VICTIMS OF POLITICAL TRAGEDY AS OF THE BRUTALITY OF KIDNAPPERS AND MILITIAMEN. THERE IS NO SHORTAGE OF EVIL IN LEBANON. BUT HAD THE HOSTAGE HOLDERS AND THE PRISON GUARDS NOT BEEN INVISIBLY MUTILATED BY THE TERRIBLE EVENTS THAT HAVE TAKEN PLACE HERE, WOULD THEY TREAT THEIR CAPITVES SO CRUELLY? PERHAPS THE FREE PRISONERS - WESTERNER AND LEBANESE ALIKE - WILL HAVE TO SUGGEST WHETHER THE MORAL RESPONSE SHOULD BE REVENGE OR FORGIVENESS, IN A RUINED LAND WHERE JUSTICE IS AS RARE AS MERCY."

ISRAELI LOAN GUARANTEES:

THE INDEPENDENT CARRIED THE ONLY STORY ON THE PRESIDENT'S ATTEMPTS TO GET CONGRESSIONAL DISCUSSION OF LOAN GUARANTEES DELAYED. IN "BUSH ROUTS JEWISH LOBBY IN FIGHT OVER AID", WASHINGTON CORRESPONDENT JOHN LICHFIELD REPORTED: "IN AN UNPRECEDENTED PUBLIC DEFEAT FOR THE AMERICAN JEWISH LOBBY, PRESIDENT BUSH ROUTED EFFORTS BY JERUSALEM TO FORCE EARLY AGREEMENT ON A TEN

BILLION DOLLAR U.S. LOAN GUARANTEE TO ISRAEL. BOTH THE ISRAELI GOVERNMENT AND ITS SUPPORTERS IN THE U.S. CONGRESS NOW ACCEPT THAT THE WHITE HOUSE WILL DELAY ALL DECISIONS ON THE LOANS FOR FOUR MONTHS - WELL BEYOND THE INTENDED START OF A MIDDLE EAST PEACE CONFERENCE..."

UNITED NATIONS:

THE FINANCIAL TIMES' LIONEL BARBER REPORTED FROM NEW YORK, "U.N. TAKES HESITANT MOVES TO ARMED INTERVENTION" AND SAID: "...THE QUESTION WHICH NO LONGER REMAINS TABOO IS: SHOULD THE PRINCIPLE OF MULTILATERAL INTERVENTION BE EXTENDED TO CONTAIN THE NEW FORCES OF NATIONALISM LET LOOSE BY THE COLLAPSE OF COMMUNISM IN EUROPE AND ASIA - FORCES WHICH NOW CHALLENGE ESTABLISHED BORDERS, THREATEN HUMAN RIGHTS AND JEOPARDIZE STABILITY ACROSS THE CONTINENT? HAS THE U.N. A ROLE TO PLAY IN A MORE AMBITIOUS FORM OF COLLECTIVE SECURITY?...SOME COUNTRIES SUCH AS CHINA AND INDIA RECOGNIZE THE TREND - AND OBJECT STRONGLY -NOT LEAST BECAUSE THEY HAVE DIFFICULTIES WITH, SAY, TIBET AND SECESSIONIST-MINDED KASHMIR.

EARLY MORNING TELEVISION AND RADIO CONTINUED TO REPORT

THE PROBLEMS WITH THE U.N. INSPECTION OF IRAQI MISSILE SITES.

BBC TV'S CORRESPONDENT AT THE U.N., GAVIN ESLER REPORTED: "IN ACCEPTING WHAT DIPLOMATS CHARACTERIZE AS AN IRAQI CLIMBDOWN, THE U.N. DOES NOT WANT TO BE SEEN NEGOTIATING WITH BAGHDAD OVER THE CONDUCT OF WEAPONS SITES INSPECTION. BUT AFTER YET ANOTHER SECURITY COUNCIL SESSION, THE HOPE WAS THE STAND-OFF IN THE BAGHDAD CAR PARK MIGHT HAVE REACHED THE ENDGAME...

"WITH AMERICAN F-111 WARPLANES ARRIVING IN EASTERN TURKEY, THE U.S. CONTINUES TO PLAY UP THE MILITARY ALONGSIDE THE DIPLOMATIC TRACK. THE BUSH ADMINISTRATION CHARACTERIZED THE IRAQI POLICY AS 'CHEAT AND RETREAT'...

"AND DIPLOMATS SEE PLENTY OF POSSIBILITIES FOR FURTHER CONFRONTATION, WITH ANOTHER U.N. TEAM SCHEDULED TO TRAVEL TO BAGHDAD TO BEGIN A HELICOPTER HUNT FOR SCUD MISSILE SITES. WHETHER THAT TEAM SHOULD GO IF THEIR COLLEAGUES ARE STILL DETAINED IS OPEN TO QUESTION."

PRESS CONTINUES TO GIVE PROMINENCE TO THE HOLDING OF THE U.N. NUCLEAR INSPECTION TEAM IN A BAGHDAD CAR PARK, AND A NEW LETTER FROM THE IRAQIS TO THE SECURITIY COUNCIL SAYING IT WOULD NOT ALLOW U.N. HELICOPTERS TO FLY OVER THE COUNTRY. THE TIMES SAID THE SECURITY COUNCIL "DECIDED NOT TO RISE TO THE CHALLENGE", AND THAT, "UNWILLING TO HEAR SUCH BAD NEWS, THE COUNCIL DECIDED THE IRAQI LETTER HAD CROSSED WITH A LETTER SENT TO BAGHDAD EARLIER IN THE DAY...AND CHOSE TO IGNORE IT."

--"HUGE NETWORK OF WESTERN FIRMS SUPPLYING IRAQ" (TIMES PAGE 1)

THE CONSERVATIVE TIMES' DEFENSE CORRESPONDENT AND WASHINGTON CORRESPONDENT MARTIN FLETCHER REPORTED: "HUNDREDS OF WESTERN COMPANIES HAVE BEEN IDENTIFIED BY UNITED NATIONS INSPECTORS AS HAVING SUPPLIED IRAQ WITH TECHNOLOGY AND EQUIPMENT FOR ITS CLANDESTINE NUCLEAR WEAPONS PROGRAM.

"DETAILS OF THE TRADE ARE EXPOSED IN DOCUMENTS SEIZED BY U.N. TEAM NOW DETAINED IN BAGHDAD. THE RECORDS GO BACK TO 1980 AND COVER FIRMS FROM DOZENS OF COUNTRIES, INCLUDING BRITAIN, AMERICA, GERMANY, FRANCE, SWITZERLAND, CHINA AND BRAZIL.

"LAST NIGHT, THE 44 INSPECTORS WITH THE BOXES OF PAPERS THEY CONFISCATED FROM THE IRAQI ATOMIC ENERGY COMMISSION ON TUESDAY WERE STILL BESIEGED IN A CAR PARK AT THE COMMISSION COMPOUND. IRAQ SAYS THE DOCUMENTS ARE THE PERSONNEL RECORDS AND NOT SUBJECT TO ANY U.N. RESOLUTIONS. BUT IT HAS OFFERED TO LET THE INSPECTROS GO WITH THE PAPERS, IF THEY AND BAGHDAD OFFICAILS COMPLETE A JOINT INVENTORY OF WHAT IS TAKEN, AN ARRANGEMENT ACCEPTED YESTERDAY BY THE U.N. SECURITY COUNCIL...

"MEANWHILE IRAQ APPEARED TO DEFY THE U.N. AGAIN LAST NIGHT WITH A LETTER REGISTERING ITS STIFF TERMS FOR THE USE OF U.N. HELICOPTERS BUT THE SECURITY COUNCIL DECIDED NOT TO RISE TO THE CHALLENGE.

"THE FIRST CLUE TO THE BREADTH OF INFORMATION CONTAINED IN THE PAPER EMERGED ON WEDNESDAY, WHEN COLIN POWELL, CHAIRMAN OF THE AMERICAN JOINT CHIEFS OF STAFF, DESCRIBED THEM AS A GOLDMINE THAT PROVIDED IRAQ WITH CONTACTS AROUND THE WORLD TO PROCURE NUCLEAR WEAPONS TECHNOLOGY..."

THE TIMES' DAVID WATTS REPORTED: "HOW DO YOU WHILE WAY THE HOURS IN A BUS IN A BAGHDAD CAR PARK WITH MORE THAN 100 HUMORLESS IRAQI SECURITY MEN TO SPOIL YOUR FUN?

"FOR THE RESOURCEFUL UNITED NATIONS NUCLEAR INSPECTORS USED TO OUT-THINKING SADDAM HUSSEIN, THERE IS MUCH TO DO: PLAY CHESS WITH BOTTLE TOPS OF AMERICAN FOOTBALL WITH TOILET ROLLS FOR A BALL. FOR THE REALLY BRAVE, THERE ARE ARABIC LESSONS, BUT DAVID KAY, THE LEADER OF THE GROUP, SAID LAST NIGHT: 'IT'S VERY MUCH AN UPHILL BATTLE. I DON'T THINK THEY'RE GOING TO IMPROVE MY LANGUAGE SKILLS VERY MUCH.'

THE TIMES' CORRESPONDENT IN NEW YORK, JAMES BONE, REPORTED: "IRAQ LAST NIGHT APPEARED TO DEFY THE UNITED NATIONS ONCE AGAIN OVER THE USE OF U.N. HELICOPTERS BUT THE SECURITY COUNCIL DECIDED NOT TO RISE TO THE CHALLENGE.

"EVEN AS THE THREE-DAY SIEGE OF U.N. INSPECTORS IN A BAGHDAD CAR PARK SEEMED TO BE DRAWING TO A CLOSE, IRAQ SENT A NEW LETTER TO THE SECURITY COUNCIL REITERATING ITS EARLIER CONDITIONS ON THE USE OF HELICOPTERS BY THE U.N. INSPECTION TEAMS. UNWILLING TO HEAR SUCH BAD NEWS, THE COUNCIL DECIDED THE IRAQI LETTER HAD CROSSED WITH A LETTER SENT TO BAGHDAD EARLIER IN THE DAY BY ROLF EKEUS, CHAIRMAN OF THE U.N. SPECIAL COMMISSION CHARGED WITH DISARMING IRAA, AND CHOSE TO IGNORE IT..."

THE TIMES' RICHARD BEESTON REPORTED FROM JERUSALEM: "ISRAEL WOULD ALMOST CERTAINLY RESPOND MILITARILY AGAINST IRAQ IF THERE WERE RENEWED HOSTILITIES IN THE GULF REGION AND FRESH MISSILE ATTACKS ON ITS TERRITORY.

"ISRAELI MILITARY SOURCES AND OBSERVERS SAID YESTERDAY THAT THEY BELIEVED AN IRAQI OFFENSIVE AGAINST ISRAEL WAS UNLIKELY, BUT RECALLED THAT PRESIDENT SADDAM

HUSSEIN HAD THE CAPABILITY AND THE POLITICAL NERVE TO-ORDER A NEW SCUD ATTACK AGAINST ISRAEL...

"SENIOR MILITARY SOURCES SAID THAT THE ISRAELIS WERE READY BOTH DEFENSIVLY AND OFFENSIVELY FOR ANY EVENTUALITY AND IF ATTACKED WOULD RESPOND QUICKLY USING AIR AND GROUND FORCES...

"BUT ONE SENIOR OFFICER PREDICTED YESTERDAY THAT THE DEFENSIVE OPERATIONS WOULD BE SHORTLIVED IF THERE WERE FUTURE IRAQI MISSILE ATTACKS BECAUSE THE ISRALIE PUBLIC, MILITARY HIERARCHY AND GOVERNMENT WOULD INSIST ON RAPID AND DECISIVE RETALIATION..."

THE TIMES CARRIED AN ARTICLE BY BRITISH CHIEF PROSECUTOR DURING THE NUREMBURG TRIALS, LORD SHAWCROSS: "...WHY DID THE ALLIES' NOT CARRY OUT THEIR INTENTION IN MRS. THATCHER'S WORDS - 'TO BRING SADDAM TO TRIAL FOR PERPRETRATING THESE BRUTAL CRUELTIES, JUST AS HAPPENED AFTER THE SECOND WORLD WAR'? CERTAINLY THE REASON WAS NOT, AS SOME HAVE INFERRED FROM THE WORDS OF THE FOREIGN SECRETARY DOUGLAS HURD, THAT OUR FORCES COULD NOT BE RELIED UPON TO DO THEIR DUTY AFTER THE INTENSIVE BOMBING AFTER THE MASSACRE AT MUTLA RIDGE. THEY MAY HAVE BEEN RELUCTANT TO ENGAGE IN FURTHER BOMBINGS OF THIS SORT BUT NONE WAS NEEDED.
