1. The attached Project Outline is presented for termination as of 1 June 1960. Renewal of it was requested for the period 1 June 1960 to 31 May 1961 but was disapproved. During the project year 1 June 1959 to 31 May 1960 [ ] was obligated for this project. No additional money is needed.

2. The objectives of this project were to provide the Polish operations run from the Berlin Base or other bases and stations with support assets such as: a high and a medium security economy safe-house; garage for a German-plated vehicle; an agent/cutout for obtaining credit investigations on persons of operational interest; an agent for monitoring local Polish emigre activity; an agent/photo point resident for obtaining clandestine photographs of the West Berlin Polish installation as well as other support facilities as required.

3. Although this project has served its purpose in supporting Polish operations in the Berlin area, it is the consensus of opinion that support of this kind is a base responsibility and should be incorporated in a general base project. We are sure that such is a preferred arrangement because it provides more flexibility in whatever support is needed by the Berlin Base at any given time.

4. The following action will be or has been taken on the personnel of this project:

A. [ ] is a 67 year old West Berlin businessman, Polish by birth but not stateless, who is used as a cutout for obtaining credit investigations on persons of operational interest. His OA was granted 7 June 1955. He will probably be transferred to a base project.

B. [ ] is a 66 year old German citizen who is a safehousekeeper at the main safe apartment. She believes the apartment belongs to an American newspaper man who occasionally visits Berlin. Her OA was granted on 14 January 1958. Her services will be terminated shortly and a bonus up to \$250 was approved to be paid from OGA funds.

C. [ ] is a 57 year old West German who is a school custodian. His apartment is used by our technicians to take photographs of employees and/or visitors to the Polish installation located across the street. His OA was granted on 3 June 1960. He will be included in the [ ] Outline when it is submitted for renewal.

D. [ ] is a 47 year old resident of West Berlin, now a West German citizen, who grew up in Poland. He is a laborer/truck driver who serves us as a legman, spotter and informant on Polish emigre circles in Berlin in which he is active. His OA was granted on 7 March 1955. He was terminated in August 1960. A bonus up to \$600 was authorized from OGA funds.

5. The vehicle used in this project and kept in an economy garage is seven years old and cannot be used by other Berlin activities. Authority is being granted to dispose of it through local Department of Army channels. No replacement will be required at this time.

6. The only problem involving the assets of this project was the termination of [ ] He had been a Western agent for about nine years and according to a recent security review has had 13 known or possible FIS provocations aimed at him since 1957. Recently it was learned that the Polish Intelligence Service had him "pegged" as an American Intelligence Agent. This will be taken into account in considering future development of operations in which he may have been involved.

7. The liaison with the Berlin unit of the British Intelligence Service and the British Element of the Allied Control Authority of Berlin and the intragency coordination with the Technical Services Staff conducted under this project will be transferred to the [ ] [ ]
