BEHELEIT, Albert German: born Bourdome (Lorraine) 18.5.00; reported in February 1944 to be in charge of the Monaco branch of the "Intercommerciale" Co., and to be a suspected agent of the Sipo & SD. Address: Villa Miraflores, Monte Carlo.

BEHER, Leutnant German: member of II/4 Brandenburg Regiment; wounded and sent on sick leave to Berlin in December 1943.

BEHLE, Oberstleutnant German: Ic officer with the local Army Command at Salonika, where he was first reported in March 1943, for purposes of liaison with the Abwehr.

BEHNKE, Hans German: born 1.5.92; tobacconist of Herslebsgt. 15, Oelo; Sipo & SD agent; reported in February 1944 to have been seen at an interrogation at Victoria Terrasse and to have been connected with Paul TUCKEL.

BEHOUZER See BACHAUER, Anton

BEHR, Unteroffizier German: interpreter, reported in March 1942 to be attached to KO Bulgaria; from January to May 1943 was at Skoplje, but is believed subsequently to have been returned to his unit; reported at Belgrade early in February 1944.

BEHREND, Bernard Hermann German: SD interpreter at the German Consulate-General in Lisbon in July 1944; formerly interpreter at the German Legation in Tangier.

BEHREND, Gruppenführer Dr. Hermann German: born Wilhelmshaven 11.5.07; head of the Eastern Branch of SD (Berlin, Brandenburg and East Prussia) in 1934; succeeded MEYGSNER as HSSuPr Serbia in April 1944; Party Nos. 981 and 960; SS 35815; Ehrdeg. RFSS; TK Ring; Cob. Ehrz; was intimate with HEYDRICH, whom he first met at his parents' restaurant in Wilhelmshaven; short, sandy hair, scar on cheek, bow-legged.

BEHREND, SOHN German: stated in a report of January 1944 to be an Abwehr officer stationed at Perpignan and to be responsible for the training and dispatch of agents.

BEHREND(T), Hauptmann German: born c.1907; Sonderführer IH Alst Paris; reported to be a recruiting agent in January 1944 and to be serving with the rank of Hauptmann in an Abwehrkommando in the Toulouse area in the summer of 1944.

BEHRENDT, Obergefreiter German: I1 (W/T operator) attached to Nest Bordeaux in 1942 and last reported at Limoges in September 1943; may be identical with a BEHRENDT, reported in July 1941 to be a member of Nest Toulon.

BEHRENS, Major German: officer of Abt III Abwehr Amt in 1938, but may have now left the Abwehr; promoted Major on 1.9.35; possibly identical with Major Ernst BEHRENS, whose address in 1939 was Berlin-Halensee, Paulsbornerstrasse 7, (tel. 974687).

BEHRENS, Obersturmführer German: member of Sipo & SD Bergen in September 1941.

BEHRENS, Anton
© BEHTRAN, Adolf (?) German: born 1884; agent of Abt II Abwehr Amt; during the last war, and subsequently, is believed to have been engaged in subversive work among the French North African tribes; visited Madrid in February 1943 with Hptm. NEITZERT; returned to Berlin in connection with a Gruppe II project to drop him by parachute among the Beni Snassen tribe in French North Africa with a view to stirring up trouble; went to Madrid for this purpose under commercial cover in June or July 1943, but fell ill and, while in hospital, talked indiscreetly about his activities and was therefore recalled to Berlin in August 1943; believed to be normally clean-shaven, but in the summer of 1943 wore a large greyish beard, probably as a disguise; passport No. 1378/43 issued Berlin 6.6.43.
